11 SECTION 75. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
12 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER
13 AUTHORIZED - BURN CENTER. The Arkansas Children's Hospital may request the
14 Chief Fiscal Officer of the State to transfer the sum of not to exceed
15 \$1,000,000 each fiscal year from the Miscellaneous Agencies Fund Account from
16 funds made available by this Act for the Arkansas Children's Hospital Burn
17 Center to the Department of Human Services Grants Fund Account. The
18 transferred funds shall be used to match federal funds used for supplemental
19 Medicaid payments to Arkansas Children's Hospital.

20 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2015~~
21 2016 through June 30, ~~2016~~ 2017.

22
23 SECTION 76. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
24 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.
25 INNOVATION AND PROJECT DEVELOPMENT FUND TRANSFERS. The Department of
26 Information Systems is a cost recovery agency subject to the requirements of
27 the United States Office of Management and Budget Circular A-87 Cost
28 Principles for State, Local and Indian Tribal Government (A-87) and Cost
29 Principles for Developing Cost Allocation Plans and Indirect Cost Rates for
30 Agreements with the Federal Government Implementation Guide for the Office of
31 Management and Budget Circular A-87 (ASMBC-10). To comply with these federal
32 rules, it is necessary to establish an Innovation and Project Development
33 appropriation and general revenue fund account within the Department of
34 Finance and Administration Disbursing Officer for the Department of
35 Information Systems. This fund shall be used for state enterprise innovation
36 projects that would enhance the technology operations of the State that

1 cannot be cost allocated to federal programs. The Department of Information
2 Systems will maintain documentation for projects billed for these purposes.
3 Fund transfers may be made from the General Revenue Fund Account, upon the
4 approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and prior review of the
5 Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee, to reimburse the
6 Department of Information Systems for the amounts billed.

7 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2015~~
8 2016 through June 30, ~~2016~~ 2017.

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10 SECTION 77. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
11 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. WORK
12 FORCE 2000 DISTRIBUTION. After the amounts to be made available to the
13 various technical institutes or comprehensive lifelong learning centers have
14 been determined as set out in Arkansas Code 26-51-205(d)(2)(A) and 26-51-
15 205(d)(2)(B), such documents as may be necessary shall be processed so that
16 funds may be transferred from the Work Force 2000 Development Fund to the
17 State Treasury fund or fund account from which the technical institute or
18 comprehensive lifelong learning center draws its general revenue support.
19 Such funds as may be transferred shall not exceed 6.309% of the total funds
20 available from the Work Force 2000 Development Fund during each fiscal year.

21 In the event that a technical college, community college or educational
22 institution which receives support from the Work Force 2000 Development Fund
23 as determined by law transfers from the Arkansas Technical College and
24 Community College System for which Work Force 2000 Development Fund monies
25 are determined by law, then the actual amount of support from the Work Force
26 2000 Development Fund in the preceding fiscal year for such educational
27 institution shall be made available irrespective of any other provision of
28 law which sets out maximum levels of support from such fund.

29 The funds distributed under Arkansas Code 26-51-205(d)(2)(C) in excess of
30 those amounts collected and distributed prior to June 30, 2014 shall be
31 deposited into the Skills Development Fund to be used only for personal
32 services, grants, operation, support, and improvement of occupational,
33 vocational, technical, and workforce development programs by the Department
34 of Career Education - Office of Skills Development. The distributions of
35 funds under Arkansas Code 26-51-205(d)(2)(C) in excess of those amounts
36 collected and distributed prior to June 30, 2014 shall not apply to proceeds

1 allocated to schools, colleges and educational institutions under Arkansas
2 Code 26-51-205(d)(2)(A) and 26-51-205(d)(2)(B).

3 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2015~~
4 2016 through June 30, ~~2016~~ 2017.

5
6 SECTION 78. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
7 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER
8 PROCEDURES – EXTRA HELP. In the event that there is not sufficient
9 appropriation provided for by the General Assembly for payment of Extra Help
10 for any state agency for the period ending June 30, ~~2016~~ 2017, said agency
11 may request a transfer from appropriations provided for Extra Help in Section
12 2, Miscellaneous Transfers, herein, from the Chief Fiscal Officer of the
13 State, stating clearly the amount required. Upon approval of the Chief
14 Fiscal Officer of the State, and after seeking prior review by the Arkansas
15 Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee, the State Auditor shall be
16 notified as to the amount and the purposes for which said appropriation is to
17 be made. The appropriation shall then be established upon the books of the
18 Department of Finance and Administration and the State Auditor. Provided
19 further, that if desired, said appropriation shall be supplemental to those
20 regularly appropriated for such purposes by the General Assembly for the
21 agency.

22 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2015~~
23 2016 through June 30, ~~2016~~ 2017.

24
25 SECTION 79. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
26 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. INTRASTATE
27 METRO PLANNING GRANTS. As referenced in Section 9 of Act 637 of 1995, the
28 authorized funding for Intrastate Metro Planning Grants that are evenly
29 distributed among planning and development districts under Section 3 of this
30 act shall include the West Central Arkansas Economic Development District.

31 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2016
32 through June 30, 2017.

33
34 SECTION 80. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
35 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUND
36 USAGE AUTHORIZED. The Arkansas Children's Hospital President and C.E.O. may

1 request the Department of Human Services-Division of Medical Services to
2 retain in the Department of Human Services Grant Fund account an amount not
3 to exceed \$1,000,000 for funds made available by the act to be used to match
4 federal funds used for supplemental Medicaid payments to Arkansas Children's
5 Hospital.

6 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2015
7 2016 through June 30, ~~2016~~ 2017.

8

9 SECTION 81. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
10 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
11 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
12 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
13 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
14 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
15 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
16 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
17 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

18

19 SECTION 82. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
20 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
21 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
22 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
23 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
24 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
25 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
26 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

27

28 SECTION 83. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
29 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits
30 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
31 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2016 is essential to the operation of
32 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
33 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
34 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2016 could work irreparable harm
35 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
36 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act

1 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
2 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2016.
