b) The amount of funds received or transaction recognized or required by

If funds received from 6 a court order or settlement agreement are expended for any purpose, including 7 investor education and enforcement activities, the report must itemize 8 specific activities subject to the exclusions provided in Ark. Code Ann. 25-9 1-403(1)(B). The report shall also itemize the specific investor education

10 and enforcement activities funded for the State Securities Department.

d) An explanation of whether the funds received or transactions recognized or required from a court order or settlement are directed to a specific entity, and if so, the State Securities Department shall provide a summary of input regarding the drafting of the court order or settlement agreement.

e) A report of the rationale for disbursing funds to a specific entity if
the State Securities Department receives funds from a court order or
settlement agreement that does not require disbursement of funds to a
specific entity.

20 f) A report of current balances of all unappropriated fund holdings 21 received by court order or settlement agreement by the State Securities 22 Department.

g) The quarterly reports shall be provided no later than the 15th day of
 the month immediately following the end of each quarter.

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2016
<u>2017</u> through June 30, 2017 <u>2018</u>.

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SECTION 7. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds 28 29 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and 30 31 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 32 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 33 34 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 35 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 36 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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2	SECTION 8. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
3	Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
4	contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
5	which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
6	Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
7	manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
8	summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
9	Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
10	
11	SECTION 9. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
12	Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
13	appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
14	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2017 is essential to the operation of
15	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
16	the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
17	effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2017 could work irreparable harm
18	upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
19	programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
20	being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
21	and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2017.
