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20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

 28 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.

29 PROMOTIONAL ITEMS. The Department of Arkansas State Police is hereby
 30 authorized to purchase from Maintenance & General Operations Classifications
 31 in the Operations Appropriation provided by this Act, up to an amount not to
 32 exceed \$2,500 each fiscal year, promotional items, authorized by the Director
 33 of the Department to meet requirements of the Arkansas State Police Strategic
 34 Recruitment Plan.

35 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2016~~
 36 2017 through June 30, ~~2017~~ 2018.

2 SECTION 15. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
3 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. COURT
4 AWARDS FUND TRANSFER PROVISION. Monies deposited in the Court Awards Fund
5 each fiscal year may be used for motor vehicle purchases and associated taxes
6 and/or motor vehicle equipping and renovation costs, overtime, personal
7 services matching, agency operational needs and capital improvements for the
8 Department of Arkansas State Police. Provided however, funds received from
9 the Special State Assets Forfeiture Fund shall be deposited into the Court
10 Awards Fund to be used by the Department of Arkansas State Police for law
11 enforcement purposes consistent with governing federal law. The Department
12 of Arkansas State Police may also request a fund transfer from the Court
13 Awards Fund or the Department of Arkansas State Police Fund to the Motor
14 Vehicle Acquisition Revolving Fund. The provisions of this section shall be
15 subject to prior review and approval of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
16 Joint Budget Committee.

17 Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of
18 appropriation and general revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year
19 is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by
20 delineating such maximums in the appropriation act(s) for a state agency and
21 the general revenue allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by
22 amendment to the Revenue Stabilization law. Further, the General Assembly
23 has determined that the Department of Arkansas State Police may operate more
24 efficiently if some flexibility is provided to the Department of Arkansas
25 State Police authorizing broad powers under this Section. Therefore, it is
26 both necessary and appropriate that the General Assembly maintain oversight
27 by requiring prior approval of the Legislative Council or Joint Budget
28 Committee as provided by this section. The requirement of approval by the
29 Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee is not a severable part of this
30 section. If the requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint
31 Budget Committee is ruled unconstitutional by a court of competent
32 jurisdiction, this entire section is void.

36 SECTION 16. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS

1 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER
2 PROVISION. The Department of Arkansas State Police is hereby authorized,
3 after seeking the approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, to
4 request transfer from the appropriation made herein for "Confiscated Funds
5 Transfer" to the Overtime, Personal Services Matching, and Maintenance and
6 General Operations classifications established in the operations
7 appropriation of the Department of Arkansas State Police, and may be used for
8 overtime, personal services matching, motor vehicle purchases and associated
9 taxes and/or motor vehicle equipping/renovation costs, agency operational
10 needs and capital improvements for the Department of Arkansas State Police.
11 Fund transfers may be requested from the Court Awards Fund to the Department
12 of Arkansas State Police Fund in the same amount and for the same purposes as
13 the appropriation transfer requested under the provisions of this section.
14 The provisions of this section shall be subject to prior review and approval
15 of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee.

16 Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of
17 appropriation and general revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year
18 is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by
19 delineating such maximums in the appropriation act(s) for a state agency and
20 the general revenue allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by
21 amendment to the Revenue Stabilization law. Further, the General Assembly
22 has determined that the Department of Arkansas State Police may operate more
23 efficiently if some flexibility is provided to the Department of Arkansas
24 State Police authorizing broad powers under this Section. Therefore, it is

1 VEHICLE ACQUISITION REVOLVING FUND – MOTOR VEHICLE PURCHASES/RENOVATION. At
2 least fifty percent (50%) of the general revenues and/or general improvement
3 funds deposited into the Motor Vehicle Acquisition Revolving Fund shall be
4 used for motor vehicle purchases and/or motor vehicle renovation costs for
5 the Department of Arkansas State Police.

6 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2016~~
7 2017 through June 30, ~~2017~~ 2018.

8
9 SECTION 18. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
10 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. OVERTIME.
11 The Department of Arkansas State Police is hereby authorized to make overtime
12 payments from such funds and appropriations provided for overtime payments to
13 those officers or other employees that are currently assigned or may be
14 assigned by the Director of the Department of Arkansas State Police to
15 Special Law Enforcement Task Forces and other special programs reimbursable
16 to Arkansas State Police by federal or local authorities as approved by the
17 Director of the Department of Arkansas State Police. All such overtime
18 payments shall be processed through the State Accounting System and shall be
19 in addition to the Regular Salaries and benefits accruing to the employee.
20 Payment of overtime is the preferred method of implementing the provisions of
21 this section.

22 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2016~~
23 2017 through June 30, ~~2017~~ 2018.

24
25 SECTION 19. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
26 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. MOTOR
27 VEHICLE PURCHASE. The Department of Arkansas State Police is hereby
28 authorized to purchase motor vehicles from the appropriations authorized for
29 Capital Outlay in the State Police Operations appropriation in this Act.
30 Motor vehicles donated to Arkansas State Police and confiscated vehicles used
31 for Arkansas State Police operations shall not be included in the maximum
32 number of authorized passenger vehicles.

33 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2016~~
34 2017 through June 30, ~~2017~~ 2018.

36 SECTION 20. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS

1 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. UNIFORM
 2 EMPLOYEE HEALTH INSURANCE PROGRAM REPORTING. The Department of Arkansas
 3 State Police shall report monthly to the Governor, the Chief Fiscal Officer
 4 of the State and to the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget
 5 Committee regarding the activity and condition for the uniformed employee
 6 health insurance plan. The report shall include, but not limited to, the
 7 beginning reserve fund balance, contributions made during the month, claims
 8 paid, and the ending fund balance of the month. In the event it is determined
 9 that the cost to adequately maintain the uniform employee health insurance
 10 plan is not feasible within the existing resources available to the
 11 department, the ~~90th~~ 91st General Assembly shall study the feasibility and
 12 desirability of discontinuing the self-insurance program and instead provide
 13 medical and hospital insurance to uniform employees through the public
 14 employees insurance program.

15 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2016~~
 16 2017 through June 30, ~~2017~~ 2018.

17
 18 SECTION 21. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 19 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.
 20 EXTRAORDINARY EXPENSES. The Department of Arkansas State Police is hereby
 21 authorized to purchase from Maintenance & Operations Classifications in the
 22 Operations Appropriation provided by this Act, up to an amount not to exceed
 23 two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500) each fiscal year, for emergency
 24 purchases for food, drinks and other essential items during emergency
 25 operations only when authorized by the Agency Director. During an emergency,
 26 an ASP employee may be designated and authorized, by the Director, to incur
 27 expenses for all deployed personnel.

28 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2016~~
 29 2017 through June 30, ~~2017~~ 2018.

30
 31 SECTION 22. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 32 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. ARKANSAS
 33 WIRELESS INFORMATION NETWORK. Once the requirements of Arkansas Code §12-8-
 34 310 are satisfied, the second ~~two million dollars (\$2,000,000)~~ two million
 35 five hundred thousand dollars (\$2,500,000) deposited into the Department of
 36 Arkansas State Police Fund generated by Arkansas Code §27-16-801(a) shall be

1 used for the operations, maintenance, equipment and various system
2 requirements and expenses of the Department of Arkansas State Police -
3 Arkansas Wireless Information Network.

4 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2016~~
5 2017 through June 30, ~~2017~~ 2018.

6
7 SECTION 23. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
8 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
9 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
10 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
11 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
12 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
13 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
14 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
15 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

16
17 SECTION 24. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
18 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
19 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
20 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
21 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
22 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
23 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
24 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

25
26 SECTION 25. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
27 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits
28 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
29 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2017 is essential to the operation of
30 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
31 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
32 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2017 could work irreparable harm
33 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
34 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
35 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
36 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2017.
