For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO AMEND THE PROVISIONS APPLICABLE TO SALES BY
A COTTAGE FOOD PRODUCTION OPERATION; TO PROVIDE THAT
SALES BY A COTTAGE FOOD PRODUCTION OPERATION AT AN
ONLINE FARMERS' MARKET ARE EXEMPT FROM THE DEFINITION
OF "FOOD SERVICE ESTABLISHMENT"; AND FOR OTHER
PURPOSES.

Subtitle

TO PROVIDE THAT SALES BY A COTTAGE FOOD
PRODUCTION OPERATION AT AN ONLINE
FARMERS' MARKET ARE EXEMPT FROM THE
DEFINITION OF "FOOD SERVICE
ESTABLISHMENT".

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 20-57-201(2)(B)(vi)(a), concerning
exemptions from the definition of "food service establishment" for purposes
of the Department of Health and the Public Health Advisory Board, is amended
to read as follows:

(vi)(a) A cottage food production operation, on the
condition that the operation offers its products directly to the consumer:

- (1) From the site where the products are
produced;
- (2) At a physical or online farmers'
market;
- (3) At a county fair; or



(4) At a special event.
