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1	SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION - TANF - FOSTER CARE. There is hereby		
2	appropriated, to the Department of Human Services - Division of Children and		
3	Family Services, to be payable from the paying account as determined by the		
4	Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, for grant payments of the Department of		
5	Human Services - Division of Children and Family Services - TANF - Foster		
6	Care which shall be supplemental and in addition to those funds appropriated		
7	in Section 5 of Act 215 of 2016, the following:

13	SECTION 3. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS		
14	CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. <u>FUNDING</u>		
15	TRANSFER. Immediately upon the effective date of this Act, the Chief Fiscal		
16	Officer of the State shall transfer on his or her books and those of the		
17	State Treasurer and the Auditor of the State the sum of fourteen million		
18	dollars (\$14,000,000) from the General Revenue Allotment Reserve Fund to the		
19	Children and Family Services Fund for the administration and operation of the		
20	Department of Human Services - Division of Children and Family Services.		
21			
22	SECTION 4. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds		
23	authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency		
24	and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and		
25	the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and		
26	Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary		
27	Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal		
28	control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by		
29	the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be		
30	strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.		
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32	SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General		
33	Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations		
34	contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for		
35	which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive		
36	Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget		

1	manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or		
2	summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative		
3	Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.		
4			
5	SECTION 6. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General		
6	Assembly, that funds provided by the General Assembly for the operations of		
7	the Department of Human Services - Division of Children and Family Services		
8	are, due to unforeseen circumstances, insufficient for the Department of		
9	Human Services - Division of Children and Family Services to continue to		
10	provide essential governmental services; that the provisions of this act will		
11	provide the necessary monies for the Department of Human Services - Division		
12	of Children and Family Services to continue such services; and that a delay		
13	in the effective date of this Act could work irreparable harm upon the proper		
14	administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore,		
15	an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the		
16	immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in		
17	full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.		
18	If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall		
19	become effective on the expiration of the period of time during which the		
20	Governor may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the		
21	veto is overridden, it shall become effective on the date the last house		
22	overrides the veto.		
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
