AN ACT TO REAPPROPRIATE THE BALANCES OF CAPITAL
IMPROVEMENT APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF
FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION - BUILDING AUTHORITY
DIVISION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND
ADMINISTRATION - BUILDING AUTHORITY
DIVISION REAPPROPRIATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. REAPPROPRIATION - GENERAL IMPROVEMENT FUND. There is hereby
appropriated, to the Department of Finance and Administration - Building
Authority Division, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its
successor fund or fund accounts, for the Department of Finance and
Administration - Building Authority Division the following:

(A) Effective July 1, 2017, the balance of the appropriation provided
in Item (A) Section 1 of Act 106 of 2016, for maintenance, renovation,
equipping, construction, acquisition, improvement, upgrade and repair
projects for all state-owned real property and facilities, in a sum not to
exceed.....\$326,741.

(B) Effective July 1, 2017, the balance of the appropriation provided
in Item (B) Section 1 of Act 106 of 2016, for maintenance, renovation,
equipping, construction, acquisition, improvement, upgrade, and repair
projects for all state-owned real property and facilities, in a sum not to
exceed.....\$434,740.



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2 SECTION 2. REAPPROPRIATION - CAPITAL PROJECTS. There is hereby
3 appropriated, to the Department of Finance and Administration - Building
4 Authority Division, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its
5 successor fund or fund accounts, for the Department of Finance and
6 Administration - Building Authority Division the following:

7 (A) Effective July 1, 2017, the balance of the appropriation provided
8 in Item (A) Section 3 of Act 106 of 2016, for various maintenance,
9 renovation, equipping, construction, acquisition, improvement, upgrade and
10 repair projects for all state-owned real property and facilities, in a sum
11 not to exceed.....\$40,000,000.
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13 SECTION 3. REAPPROPRIATION - NATURAL AND CULTURAL RESOURCES COUNCIL -
14 STATE OWNED LANDS OR HISTORIC SITES - ARKANSAS GOVERNOR'S MANSION
15 PRESERVATION. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Finance and
16 Administration - Building Authority Division, to be payable from the Arkansas
17 Natural and Cultural Resources Grant and Trust Fund, for the Department of
18 Finance and Administration - Building Authority Division the following:

19 (A) Effective July 1, 2017, the balance of the appropriation provided
20 in Section 24 of Act 253 of 2016, for the acquisition, management,
21 stewardship or preservation of state owned lands, historic sites, buildings,
22 structures or objects, in a sum not to exceed.....\$783,540.

24 SECTION 4. DISBURSEMENT CONTROLS. (A) No contract may be awarded nor
25 obligations otherwise incurred in relation to the project or projects
26 described herein in excess of the State Treasury funds actually available
27 therefor as provided by law. Provided, however, that institutions and
28 agencies listed herein shall have the authority to accept and use grants and
29 donations including Federal funds, and to use its unobligated cash income or
30 funds, or both available to it, for the purpose of supplementing the State
31 Treasury funds for financing the entire costs of the project or projects
32 enumerated herein. Provided further, that the appropriations and funds
33 otherwise provided by the General Assembly for Maintenance and General
34 Operations of the agency or institutions receiving appropriation herein shall
35 not be used for any of the purposes as appropriated in this act.

36 (B) The restrictions of any applicable provisions of the State

Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law and any other applicable fiscal control laws of this State and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of any funds provided by this act unless specifically provided otherwise by law.

SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

SECTION 6. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2017 is essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2017 could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2017.
