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5	SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the		
6	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that there is a critical need to		
7	ensure safe and secure public buildings and other facilities for the citizens		
8	of Arkansas on the grounds of the State Capitol; and that a delay in the		
9	effective date of this act could irreparably harm the ability of the		
10	Secretary of State to provide necessary upgrades and repairs to the grounds		
11	and facilities of the State Capitol. Therefore, an emergency is declared to		
12	exist, and this act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the		
13	public peace, health, and safety shall become effective on:		
14	(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;		
15	(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,		
16	the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the		
17	bill; or		
18	(3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is		
19	overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.		
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
