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(C) Solid waste management districts may charge a fee for the collection and disposal of specialty tires. (D) It shall be the responsibility of the tire retailer to accept at no additional cost to the customer other than the fees imposed under this section any or all used or waste tires for which a new replacement tire was purchased. (E) For any used or waste tires collected through a tire retailer's business, the retailer shall ensure that the tires are transported by a licensed hauler to a permitted waste tire collection center, a solid waste management facility, a waste tire processing facility, or a registered used tire dealer. (F) At the time of registration with the Office of Motor Vehicle, the new tire fee imposed under subdivision (a)(3)(A) of this section shall be paid to the office for each new tire on each new automobile, motorcycle, and trailer sold in this state. (G) The new tire fee imposed under subdivision (a)(3)(A)of this section shall be paid by: (i) A person that mounts a new tire that was not purchased at the person's place of business; and (ii) A fleet owner, including a state agency, a municipality, or a private fleet that mounts tires on the fleet owner's vehicles.

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
