10	9-10-302. Definitions.
11	As used in this subchapter:
12	(1) "Broker" means a person or entity that knowingly seeks to
13	introduce or match a prospective mother with a prospective intended parent
14	for the purposes of initiating, assisting, or facilitating a surrogacy
15	<pre>arrangement;</pre>
16	(2) "Commercial surrogacy" means a surrogacy arrangement
17	<pre>involving either:</pre>
18	(A) The payment, or agreement to pay, an amount of money
19	or any valuable consideration to a broker; or
20	(B) The payment, or agreement to pay, an amount of money
21	or valuable consideration, other than payment or reimbursement of medical and
22	hospital expenses as authorized under § 9-9-206(c) to a mother;
23	(3) "Intended parent" means a person who is intended to be the
24	person or one (1) of the persons designated to raise a child following birth;
25	(4) "Mother" means a woman who carries and gives birth to a
26	child, regardless of whether she is genetically related to the child; and
27	(5) "Surrogacy" means an arrangement, regardless of whether
28	embodied in a written or oral contract, that is entered into by two (2) or
29	more people and regarding the participation in the creation of a child, with
30	the intent that the child will be reared as the child of one (1) or more of
31	the intended parents.
32	
33	9-10-303. Surrogacy agreement unenforceable.
34	A surrogacy agreement is unenforceable in the State of Arkansas,
35	regardless of whether the surrogacy agreement was entered into in the state.
36	

1	9-10-304. Resolution of disputes.
2	A dispute, including a custody dispute, concerning a child born as a
3	result of a surrogacy arrangement and that falls within the jurisdiction of a
4	court within the state shall be resolved according to the laws of the state.
