24	(a) <u>(1) Except as provided in subdivision (a)(2) of this section,</u>	
25	<u>permissible</u> <i>Permissible</i> items of fireworks, defined in § 20-22-708, may be	
26	sold at retail to residents of the State of Arkansas and used within the	
27	State of Arkansas from June 20 through July 10 and December 10 through	
28	January 5 of each year only.	
29	(2) Permissible items of fireworks as defined in § 20-22-708 may	<u>v</u>
30	be sold at retail all-year if sold in a permanent physical location.
