 - (3) Each Agency, Board, Commission or Institution shall provide a written report to the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee containing all information set forth in item (2) above, along with a written statement as to the current status of the project, contract, purpose etc. for which the carry forward was originally requested no later than thirty (30) days prior to the time the Agency, Board, Commission or Institution presents its budget request to the Arkansas Legislative Council/Joint Budget Committee; and
- (4) Thereupon, the Department of Finance and Administration shall include all information obtained in item (3) above in the budget manuals and/or a statement of non-compliance by the Agency, Board, Commission or Institution.
- The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, $\frac{2016}{2017}$ through June 30, $\frac{2017}{2018}$.

SECTION 21. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS

CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. SALARY OF

THE COMMISSIONER OF THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION. It is the intent of the

General Assembly that the appropriation for the salary of the Commissioner of

the Department of Education shall be the sole and exclusive authority for his

35 or her salary. It is further the intent of the General Assembly that the

36 Commissioner be required to devote all of his or her working time exclusively

- 1 to the performance of his or her duties as Commissioner of the Department of

- 18 ESTABLISHMENT OF A "POSITION POOL". (a) To address needs emerging from
- 19 statewide education issues and the necessity of recruiting and retaining
- 20 qualified personnel, the Arkansas Department of Education or its successor
- 21 agency is authorized for the $\frac{2016-2017}{2017}$ 2017-2018 fiscal year a pool of no
- 22 more than five (5) Professional/Executive positions at a salary not to exceed
- 23 the maximum salary for a grade N912. These positions are to be used by the
- 24 Department of Education in the event that the personal services needs of the
- 25 Department during the 2016-2017 2017-2018 fiscal year require additional
- 26 positions, either by title or in number, that are not authorized by the

- 34 grade Cl30. These positions are to be used by the Department of Education in
- 35 the event that the personal services needs of the Department during the 2016-
- 36 2017 2017-2018 fiscal year require additional positions, either by

- 1 classification or in number, that are not authorized by the General Assembly 2 in the Regular Salaries section of this Act. These positions may also be used 3 to properly classify positions when the Department does not have a vacant

 - (d) The Department of Education is authorized to access the pool positions authorized in this Section at any time when it is determined by the Commissioner that the need exists. The Commissioner shall provide a monthly report of the justification for the need to allocate titles from this growth pool to the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and to the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee for review. The report shall also include an accounting of the names, titles, and salaries of personnel whose salaries have been adjusted under provisions of Subsections (a) and (b) of this Section.
 - (e) If the Department of Education requests continuation of any "Position Pool" position(s) as established herein during the next fiscal year, the position(s) must be requested as a new position(s) in the agency's budget request.
- (f) Determining the number of personnel to be employed by a state agency is the prerogative of the General Assembly and is usually accomplished by delineating the maximum number of personnel by identifying job titles and the maximum grade or salary attached to those titles. The General Assembly has determined that the Arkansas Department of Education could be operated more efficiently if some flexibility is given to that agency. That flexibility is being accomplished by providing a position pool in Subsections (a) and (b) of this Section and since the General Assembly has granted the agency broad powers under the growth pool concept, it is both necessary and appropriate that the General Assembly maintain oversight of the utilization of the position pool by requiring review of the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee in the utilization of the position pool. Therefore, the requirement of review by the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee is not a 35 severable part of this section. If the requirement of review by the

Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee is ruled unconstitutional by a

- l court of competent jurisdiction, this entire section is void.

EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the 20 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the 21 22 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2017 is essential to the operation of 23 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in 24 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2017 could work irreparable harm 25 26 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental 27 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health 28 29 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2017. 30 31 32 33 34 35

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
