SECTION 16. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 4 5 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 6 TO FACILITIES MANAGEMENT CONTINGENCY APPROPRIATION AUTHORITY. (a) In order to 7 provide a more cost effective method to address the emerging infrastructure 8 needs of Arkansas State Government, appropriations and funds transferred to 9 the Facilities Management Contingency Appropriation are to be used in the 10 event that the Department of Finance and Administration - Building Authority 11 Division executes one or more building contracts or maintenance agreements 12 with State Agencies, and the appropriations or funds otherwise provided for 13 the Department of Finance and Administration - Building Authority Division 14 are not sufficient to address those needs, and it is more cost effective for 15 the Department of Finance and Administration - Building Authority Division to 16 execute these services. Any State Agency may transfer or deposit funds and 17 appropriations to the Department of Finance and Administration - Building 18 Authority Division - Facilities Management Contingency Appropriation 19 authorized in the Building Maintenance Section of this Act to execute one or 20 more building contracts or maintenance agreements with said State Agencies. 21 The Department of Finance and Administration - Building Authority Division 22 shall provide justification to the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State for the 23 need of such appropriations and funds transfers and seek and receive approval 24 of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State. Department of Finance and 25 Administration - Building Authority Division shall then seek and receive the 26 approval of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee. 27 requirement of approval by the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget 28 Committee is not a severable part of the section. If the requirement of 29 approval by the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee is 30 ruled unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, this entire 31 section is void.

(b) The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall make the necessary adjustments on his or her books and the books of the Auditor of the State for the transfer or deposit of the funds and appropriations from each State Agency to the appropriation authorized in the Building Maintenance Section of this Act and to the various Department of Finance and Administration -

SECTION 24. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

SECTION 25. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

35 36 SECTION 26. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2017 is essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in

T	the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
2	effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2017 could work irreparable harm
3	upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
4	programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
5	being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
