25	<u>17-95-1001. Ti</u>	<u>ttle.</u>	
26	This subchapter	shall be known and may be cited as	the "Arkansas
27	Surgical Technologist	s Act".

29	<u>17-95-1002</u> . De	efinitions.	
30	As used in this	subchapter:	
31	<u>(1) "Sur</u>	gical technologist" means an indivi	dual who performs the
32	skills and techniques	s of surgical technology under the d	lirection and
33	supervision of a lice	ensed practitioner other than in the	course of practicing
34	as a licensed healtho	care professional; and	
35	<u>(2) "Sur</u>	rgical technology" means surgical pa	tient care that
36	includes without limi	tation:	

1	(A) Preparing an operating room and a sterile field for		
2	surgical procedures by ensuring that surgical equipment is assembled and		
3	functioning properly and safely;		
4	(B) Preparing sterile supplies, instruments, and equipment		
5	using sterile technique; and		
6	(C) Performing tasks in a sterile field, including:		
7	(i) Maintaining asepsis and a sterile operating		
8	<pre>field;</pre>		
9	(ii) Passing supplies, equipment, or instruments		
10	according to the needs of the surgical team;		
11	(iii) Sponging or suctioning an operative site;		
12	(iv) Preparing and cutting suture material;		
13	(v) Providing irrigation solutions to the		
14	supervising physician and irrigating an operative site;		
15	(vi) Providing drugs within the sterile field for		
16	administration by the supervising physician;		
17	(vii) Handling specimens;		
18	(viii) Holding retractors and other instruments;		
19	(ix) Applying electrocautery to clamps on blood		
20	vessels;		
21	(x) Connecting drains to a suction apparatus;		
22	(xi) Applying dressings to closed wounds; and		
23	(xii) Performing counts of supplies such as sponges,		
24	needles, and instruments with the registered nurse circulator.

26	17-95-1003. Registration.		
27	The Arkansas State Medical Board shall register as a surgical		
28	technologist an applicant who:		
29	(1) Has successfully completed a nationally accredited surgical		
30	technology program and holds a current credential as a certified surgical		
31	technologist from the National Board of Surgical Technology and Surgical		
32	Assisting or its successor or a national organization approved by the		
33	Arkansas State Medical Board;		
34	(2) Has successfully completed a surgical technologist training		
35	program during the person's service as a member of any branch of the United		
36	States Armed Forces; or		

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1	(3) Has been employed to practice as a surgical technologist at		
2	any time within the six (6) months before July 1, 2017, if the applicant		
3	registers with the Arkansas State Medical Board on or before July 1, 2018.

5	17-95-1004. Title protection.		
6	A person shall not use or assume the title "registered surgical		
7	technologist" unless the person is registered with the Arkansas State Medical		
8	Board.		
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10	17-95-1005. Rules.		
11	The Arkansas State Medical Board may adopt and promulgate rules to		
12	implement this subchapter.		
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
