26 SECTION 18. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 27 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 28 ADDITIONAL POSITIONS. The Director of the Department of Workforce Services, 29 after receiving the approval of the Office of Personnel Management, and after 30 seeking the prior review by the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget 31 Committee, shall have the authority to establish such new or additional full 32 time positions as may become necessary to carry out the objectives of the 33 program and/or to meet Federal requirements of new and/or expanded programs 34 where such needs are financed by federal funds; provided that not more than 35 two hundred persons may be employed in addition to those authorized in the 36 salary schedule and that the rate of pay shall not exceed those set out in

the salary schedule for comparable positions as authorized under the
 provisions of the Regular Salaries section of this Act.

3 If the agency requests continuation of a "Growth Pool" position(s) as
4 established herein, the position(s) must be requested as a new position(s) in
5 the agency's budget request.

6 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2016
7 <u>2017</u> through June 30, 2017 <u>2018</u>.

8

SECTION 19. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 9 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER 10 11 OF APPROPRIATION. Subject to such rules and regulations as may be 12 implemented by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and after having sought the prior approval by the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget 13 14 Committee, the Director of the Department of Workforce Services is hereby 15 authorized to make transfers from any appropriation made by this Act to any 16 other appropriation made by this Act with the exception of the "Reed Act 17 Funds" appropriations set forth in the Reed Act Funds appropriation section 18 of this Act, and of the appropriation made for Regular Salaries or 19 Maintenance and General Operation. Such transfers may be made whenever it 20 appears, by projecting the expenditures of any of the appropriations in this 21 Act, that there will be a deficiency of appropriation in one item and that 22 there will be a corresponding excess of appropriation in another item or 23 items which may be transferred. The transfer of appropriation shall be 24 effected only on approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State. Provided, 25 however, that no transfer of appropriations may be authorized to increase the 26 total amount appropriated for Regular Salaries, or Maintenance and General 27 Operations, except as may be authorized elsewhere by law.

28 Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of 29 appropriation and general revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year 30 is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by 31 delineating such maximums in the appropriation act(s) for a state agency and 32 the general revenue allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by 33 amendment to the Revenue Stabilization law. Further, the General Assembly 34 has determined that the Department of Workforce Services may operate more 35 efficiently if some flexibility is provided to the Department of Workforce 36 Services authorizing broad powers under this Section. Therefore, it is both

necessary and appropriate that the General Assembly maintain oversight by requiring prior approval of the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee as provided by this section. The requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee is not a severable part of this section. If the requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee is ruled unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, this entire section is void.

11 SECTION 20. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 12 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. INTER-AGENCY TRANSFER OF STATE GENERAL REVENUE FOR THE TEMPORARY ASSISTANCE FOR 13 14 NEEDY FAMILIES (TANF) PROGRAMS. Upon the request of the Director of the 15 Department of Human Services (DHS) and the Director of the Department of 16 Workforce Services (DWS), the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State may approve 17 up to three million six hundred forty thousand six hundred fifty dollars 18 (\$3,640,650) each fiscal year in State General Revenue appropriated to DWS 19 for the TANF program to be transferred to the DHS - Division of County 20 Operations in support of Arkansas' TANF Programs or any related separate 21 state programs.

The Director of the Department of Workforce Services shall provide a report of all transfers made to the DHS - Division of County Operations to the Performance Evaluation and Expenditure Review Committee of the Arkansas Legislative Council and Joint Budget Committee. The report must include the justification for and the amount of the completed transfers.

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2016

30 SECTION 21. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 31 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER 32 OF TANF BLOCK GRANT FUNDS. Each fiscal year, the Department of Workforce 33 Services shall transfer the sum of seven million five hundred thousand 34 dollars (\$7,500,000) from the state's federal Temporary Assistance for Needy 35 Families block grant to the Department of Education Public School Fund 36 Account to be used solely for the Arkansas Better Chance Program.

1 If the state match for the Temporary Assistance for Needy Families grant 2 or the state's Temporary Assistance for Needy Families grant is reduced, the 3 amount to be transferred may be adjusted in proportion to the percentage 4 change in the state match or the state's Temporary Assistance for Needy 5 Families grant. The amount to be transferred may also be reduced 6 proportionately if new cost requirements are imposed upon the state as a 7 result of new or revised Temporary Assistance for Needy Families regulations 8 at the federal level.

9 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2016

12 SECTION 22. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRAINING 13 14 TRUST FUND TRANSFER. Immediately upon the effective date of this Act, the 15 Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall transfer on his or her books and 16 those of the State Treasurer and the Auditor of the State the sum of two 17 million five hundred thousand dollars (\$2,500,000) from the Department of 18 Workforce Services Training Trust Fund to the Skills Development Fund. 19 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2016 20 2017 through June 30, 2017 2018.

SECTION 23. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.
 RESTRICTIONS ON FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE UNDER THE TEMPORARY ASSISTANCE FOR NEEDY
 FAMILIES PROGRAM.

(a)(1) Determining the maximum number of employees, the maximum amount of appropriation, for what purposes an appropriation is authorized, and general revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year is the prerogative of the General Assembly.

30 (2) The purposes of subsection (a) of this section are typically31 accomplished by:

32 (A) Identifying the purpose in the appropriation act;
33 (B) Delineating such maximums in the appropriation act for

COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds 35 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency 36 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and

8 SECTION 25. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General 9 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations 10 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for 11 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive 12 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget 13 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or 14 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative 15 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 16

17 SECTION 26. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the 18 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits 19 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the 20 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2017 is essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in 21 22 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the 23 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2017 could work irreparable harm 24 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental 25 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act 26 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2017. 27 28 29 30 31 32 33 34
