6	SECTION 15. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
7	Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
8	contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
9	which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
10	Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
11	manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
12	summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
13	Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
14	
15	SECTION 16. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
16	Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
17	appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
18	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2017 is essential to the operation of
19	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided; with the
20	exception that Sections 12 and 13 in this Act shall be in full force and
21	effect from and after the date of its passage and approval, and that in the
22	event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the effective
23	date of this Act beyond July 1, 2017, with the exception that Sections 12 and
24	13 in this Act shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of
25	its passage and approval, could work irreparable harm upon the proper
26	administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore,
27	an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the
28	immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in
29	full force and effect from and after July 1, 2017; with the exception that
30	Sections 12 and 13 in this Act shall be in full force and effect from and
31	after the date of its passage and approval.
