20	Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in	the budget

22	summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Ark	ansas Legislative
23	Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage	ge and adoption.

25	SECTION 7. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determin	ed by the General
26	Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas pro	hibits the
27	appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period;	that the
28	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2017 is essential to the	<u>e operation of</u>
29	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are prov	ided, and that in
30	the event of an extension of the legislative session, the de	lay in the
31	effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2017 could work in	reparable harm
32	upon the proper administration and provision of essential go	<u>vernmental</u>
33	programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exis	t and this Act
34	being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public	peace, health
35	and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after	July 1, 2017.
