25	SECTION 1. Arkansas	Code § 5-71-101, concerning de	finitions that
26	concern offenses against p	ublic health, safety, or welfar	e, is amended to add
27	additional subdivisions to	read as follows:	
28	<u>(10)</u> "Alcohol:	ic beverage" means:	
29	<u>(</u> A) Been	r, ale, porter, stout, sake, or	other similar
30	fermented beverage of any 1	name or description containing	five-tenths percent
31	(0.5%) or more of alcohol l	by volume, brewed or produced f	rom malt, wholly or
32	in part, or from any malt s	<u>substitute;</u>	
33	<u>(B) Wine</u>	e of not less than five-tenths	percent (0.5%) of
34	alcohol by volume; or		
35	(C) A distilled spirit known as "ethyl alcohol",		
36	"ethanol", or "spirits of w	wine" in any form, including al	l dilutions and



1	mixtures of a distilled spirit, from whatever source or by whatever process		
2	produced;		
3	(11)(A) "Motor vehicle" means a vehicle driven or drawn by		
4	mechanical power and manufactured primarily for use on a public highway.		
5	(B) "Motor vehicle" does not include a vehicle operated		
6	solely on a rail or rails; and		
7	(12) "Open alcoholic beverage container" means a bottle, can, or		
8	other receptacle that:		
9	(A) Contains any amount of alcoholic beverage; and		
10	(B) Is either:		
11	(i) Open or has a broken seal; or		
12	(ii) Not open or having a broken seal but with its		
13	contents already partially removed.		
14			
15	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 5-71-218 is amended to read as follows:		
16	5-71-218. Possession of open container containing alcohol in a motor		
17	vehicle.		
18	(a) It is unlawful for a person to possess an open alcoholic beverage		
19	container within an area of a motor vehicle <del>that</del> <u>if the area of the motor</u>		
20	vehicle is:		
21	(1) Designated to seat the driver or a passenger in the motor		
22	vehicle and the motor vehicle is in operation; or		
23	(2) Readily accessible to the driver or a passenger in the motor		
24	vehicle while in a seated position and the motor vehicle is located on a		
25	public highway or the right-of-way of a public highway.		
26	(b) It is not an offense under this section if the open alcoholic		
27	beverage container is possessed:		
28	(1) Outside of the passenger area of the motor vehicle or other		
29	area of the motor vehicle commonly used for the transportation of passengers,		
30	such as in the trunk or cargo area of the motor vehicle;		
31	(2) In a locked area of the motor vehicle, including without		
32	limitation a glove compartment or center console of the motor vehicle;		
33	(3) In a permanently sealed container that cannot be unsealed		
34	without breaking the seal or destroying the container Behind the last upright		
35	seat or in an area not normally occupied by the driver or a passenger, in a		
36	motor vehicle that is not equipped with a trunk; or

1	(4) By a passenger in the motor vehicle, but not the driver, as
2	long as the open alcoholic beverage container is possessed within the living
3	quarters of the motor vehicle or the area of the motor vehicle that is
4	designated for passengers only, the open alcoholic beverage container is not
5	readily accessible to the driver of the motor vehicle, and the motor vehicle
6	is:
7	(A) Designed, maintained, or used primarily for the
8	transportation of persons for compensation; or
9	(B) A recreational vehicle, motor home, or house trailer.
10	(c) A violation of this section is a Class C misdemeanor.
