30 SECTION 6. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARRANSAS 31 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. ARKANSAS 32 CHILDREN'S HOSPITAL RESEARCH PROGRAM. In any fiscal year, if the funds 33 received by the University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences for the Arkansas 34 Biosciences Institute in the Arkansas Biosciences Institute appropriation in 35 this Act are less than the total amount appropriated, the University of 36 Arkansas for Medical Sciences shall provide no less than thirty-three and

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1 one-third percent (33 and 1/3%) of the available funds for the Arkansas 2 Children's Hospital Research Program. Otherwise, the Arkansas Children's 3 Hospital Research Program line item appropriation in the Arkansas Biosciences 4 Institute appropriation in this Act shall be funded in total or Arkansas 5 Children's Hospital Chief Executive Officer may request that the University 6 of Arkansas for Medical Sciences transfer such funds each fiscal year from 7 the Arkansas Biosciences Institute Program Account to the Department of Human 8 Services Grants Fund Account. The transferred funds shall be used to match 9 federal funds used for Supplemental Medicaid payments to Arkansas Children's 10 Hospital.

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2018
 2019 through June 30, 2019 2020.

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14 SECTION 7. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 15 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER 16 RESTRICTIONS. The appropriations provided in this act shall not be 17 transferred under the provisions of Arkansas Code 19-4-522, but only as 18 provided by this act.

19 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2018
20 2019 through June 30, 2019 2020.

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22 SECTION 8. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 23 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER 24 PROVISIONS. The state-supported institution of higher education in this act 25 may transfer appropriations between the various line items within each 26 appropriation contained in this appropriation act. Such transfers shall be 27 made only after the approval of the Department of Higher Education and the 28 Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, and the approval of the Legislative 29 Council or Joint Budget Committee.

The General Assembly has determined that the institution in this act could be operated more efficiently if some flexibility is given to that institution and that flexibility is being accomplished by providing authority to transfer between items of appropriation made by this act. Since the General Assembly has granted the institution broad powers under the transfer of appropriations, it is both necessary and appropriate that the General Assembly maintain oversight of the utilization of the transfers by requiring

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prior approval of the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee in the utilization of the transfer authority. Therefore, the requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee is not a severable part of this section. If the requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee is ruled unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, this entire section is void.

7 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2018
8 2019 through June 30, 2019 2020.

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10 SECTION 9. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 11 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 12 POSITIONS. (a) Nothing in this act shall be construed as a commitment of the 13 State of Arkansas or any of its agencies or institutions to continue funding 14 any position paid from the proceeds of the Tobacco Settlement in the event 15 that Tobacco Settlement funds are not sufficient to finance the position.

(b) State funds will not be used to replace Tobacco Settlement funds when
such funds expire, unless appropriated by the General Assembly and authorized
by the Governor.

(c) A disclosure of the language contained in (a) and (b) of this Section
shall be made available to all new hire and current positions paid from the
proceeds of the Tobacco Settlement by the Tobacco Settlement Commission.
(d) Whenever applicable the information contained in (a) and (b) of this
Section shall be included in the employee handbook and/or Professional
Services Contract paid from the proceeds of the Tobacco Settlement.
The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2018

26 <u>2019</u> through June 30, $\frac{2019}{2020}$.

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SECTION 10. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 28 29 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 30 COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by this act 31 shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made 32 available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures 33 34 Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, 35 and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and 36 regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as

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authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of said

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funds.

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4 SECTION 11. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 5 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 6 LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds 7 disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this act 8 shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act was 9 adopted, as evidenced by Initiated Act 1 of 2000, the Agency Requests, 10 Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the 11 budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, 12 letters, or summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and 13 14 adoption. 15 16 SECTION 12. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the

17 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits 18 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2019 is essential to the operation of 19 20 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the 21 22 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2019 could work irreparable harm 23 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental 24 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act 25 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health 26 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2019. 27 28 */s/Joint Budget Committee* 29 30 31 32 33 34 35

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
