25	and municipalities, is amend	ded to add an additional su	bsection to read as
26	follows:		
27	(d)(l) An audit of a	municipality under this se	ction shall also
28	include an inquiry to determ	nine whether an abuse of po	lice power has occurred
29	under the Arkansas Speed Tra	ap Law, § 12-8-401 et seq.	
30	(2) The require	ed records to be audited un	der the Arkansas Speed
31	Trap Law, § 12-8-401 et seq	., include all records, inc	luding records of
32	revenues collected over the	previous six (6) months.

34	SECTION 2. Arkansas (	Code § 12-8-402, concerning	definitions used in
35	the Arkansas Speed Trap Law	, is amended to add an addi	tional subdivision to
36	read as follows:		

1	(4) "Revenue" means moneys resulting from fines and costs from		
2	traffic offenses that are:		
3	(A) Misdemeanors;		
4	(B) Violations; or		
5	(C) Violations of a local ordinance for which citations		
6	are written by the police department of the affected municipality occurring		
7	on the affected highways.

9	SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 12-8-403 is amended to read as follows:		
10	12-8-403. Inquiry to determine abuse.		
11	(a)(1) Upon the request of the prosecuting attorney of $\frac{1}{2}$ and $\frac{1}{2}$ judicial		
12	district in which an affected municipality is located, the Director of the		
13	Department of Arkansas State Police <del>is authorized to</del> <u>may</u> investigate and		
14	determine whether $\frac{1}{2}$ the municipality is abusing police power $\frac{1}{2}$ to $\frac{1}{2}$ conducting		
15	an unlawful speed trap.		
16	(2)(A) The investigation shall require requires the affected		
17	municipality to submit a certified record of all fines, costs, citations, $\underline{anc}$		
18	municipal expenditures, and as well as the percentage of speeding citations		
19	that are written for persons speeding ten miles per hour (10 m.p.h.) or less		
20	than the posted speed <u>limit</u> .		
21	(B) The records required under subdivision $(a)(2)(A)$ of		
22	this section may be over a reasonable period of time encompass a reasonable		
23	$\underline{\text{time period}}$ as requested by the Department of Arkansas State Police, but $\underline{\text{in}}$		
24	no event shall there be less than shall contain at least ninety (90) days		
25	<u>days'</u> worth of documentation.		
26	(C)(i) The affected municipality shall submit $\underline{\text{the}}$		
27	requested records within thirty (30) days, unless an extension for submission		
28	is approved by the director, and shall cooperate with all other aspects of		
29	the investigation.		
30	(ii) Failure to comply with $any$ $a$ requirement of		
31	this section shall result in automatic sanctions.		
32	(b) It $\frac{\text{shall be}}{\text{is}}$ presumed that the affected municipality is abusing		
33	police power <u>by conducting an unlawful speed trap</u> upon a finding <u>by the</u>
