(B) The court may proceed with sentencing even in the absence of the defendant after the expiration of the fifteen (15) days under subdivision (b)(2)(A) of this section. (c) The presentence screening and assessment report shall include without limitation: (1) The defendant's driving record; (2) An alcohol problem assessment; and (3) A victim impact statement, if applicable.
