| 25 | SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 9, Chapter 32, Subchapter 1, is amended |
| 26 | to add an additional section to read as follows: |
| 27 | 9-32-101. Collaboration of state agencies to form and implement |
| 28 | statewide child abduction response teams. |
| 29 | (a)(1) The following agencies shall collaborate in a multi-agency |
| 30 | effort to rescue abducted or endangered children, implement one (1) or more |
| 31 | statewide child abduction response teams, and allocate the respective |
| 32 | resources of each agency to cases involving missing or endangered children: |
| 33 | (A) Attorney General; |
| 34 | (B) Department of Arkansas State Police; |
| 35 | <u>(C) Criminal Justice Institute;</u> |
| 36 | (D) Arkansas State Game and Fish Commission; |
