7	(c)(1) The Director of the Department of Health shall call the first		
8	meeting of the panel within thirty (30) days of the effective date of this		
9	act.		
10	(2) At the first meeting of the panel, the members of the panel		
11	shall elect from the panel's membership a chair or cochairs and other		
12	officers as needed for the transaction of its business.		
13	(3) Meetings of the panel shall be held at least one (1) time		
14	every three (3) months but may occur more often at the call of the chair or		
15	cochairs.		
16	(4) The panel shall establish rules and procedures for		
17	conducting its business.		
18	(5)(A) A majority of the members of the panel shall constitute a		
19	quorum for transacting any business of the panel.		
20	(B) An affirmative vote of a majority of a quorum present		
21	shall be required for the passage of a motion or other action of the panel.		
22	(6) The Department of Health shall provide staff, materials, and		
23	meeting space for the panel.		
24	(d) The purpose of the panel is to:		
25	(1) Advance pediatric cancer research;		
26	(2) Advance pediatric cancer treatment;		
27	(3) Improve childhood cancer surveillance; and		
28	(4) Support resources for pediatric cancer patients and		
29	survivors of childhood cancers.		
30	(e) In order to fulfill its purpose, the panel may:		
31	(1) Undertake research or other activities funded by donations		
32	or grants; and		
33	(2) Solicit and receive donations and grants.		
34	(f) The panel shall submit reports at least annually to the Director		
35	of the Department of Health concerning its activities and recommendations.		
36	(g) The panel shall expire on January 1, 2022.
