1 2 WHEREAS, in 2018, an estimated 350,000 children were served by 3 children's advocacy centers nationwide; and 4 5 WHEREAS, in 2018, 17 children's advocacy centers and 7 satellite 6 offices throughout Arkansas served an estimated 5,000 child victims of abuse, 7 providing victim advocacy and support services to them and their families; 8 and of those 5,000 children, a significant number were 12 years old or 9 younger; and 10 11 WHEREAS, although neglect is the most common form of child 12 maltreatment, victims also suffer year after year from physical abuse, sexual 13 abuse, drug endangerment, commercial sexual exploitation, and psychological 14 maltreatment; and 15 16 WHEREAS, children's advocacy centers seek to model, promote, and 17 deliver excellence in child abuse response and prevention through direct 18 service, education, collaboration, and leadership; and 19 20 WHEREAS, Children's Advocacy Centers of Arkansas is the leading 21 statewide organization supporting the multidisciplinary response to child 22 abuse; and 23 24 WHEREAS, it is appropriate to underline the growing problem of child 25 abuse and the serious impact child abuse has on the citizens of Arkansas and 26 the future generations of our state, as well as on those of the rest of the 27 nation, 28 29 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE NINETY-SECOND GENERAL 30 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN: 31 32 33 THAT the House of Representatives recognize that abuse and neglect of 34 children is a significant public health problem; commend the important work 35 being done to combat this serious public health problem; and proclaim April 36 11, 2019, as "Children's Advocacy Center Day" in Arkansas.
