DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES - GRANTS TO COMMUNITY BASED PROVIDERS. Funds 3 4 allocated under the appropriation for community-based services, for under the 5 appropriation for (i) Grants to Community Providers, in the Developmental 6 Disabilities Services - Grants-in-Aid appropriation in this act, (ii) the 7 Grants/Patient Services Line in the Operations appropriation in this act, and 8 (iii) the Inter-Divisional Programs appropriation in this act, shall be used 9 only to provide services through private community based services licensed or 10 certified by the Arkansas Division of Developmental Disabilities Services 11 (DDS) or licensed or certified by a Provider-Led Arkansas Shared Savings 12 Entity (PASSE). Non-profit community-based programs licensed by the Division of Developmental Disabilities Services are quasi-governmental 13 14 instrumentalities of the state which provide supports and services to 15 individuals who have a developmental disability or delay, who would otherwise 16 require supports and services through state-operated programs and facilities 17 owned by the State of Arkansas. When <del>DDS</del> licensed providers are involved in 18 delivering services which are Medicaid reimbursable, they must enroll as a 19 provider with the Arkansas Medicaid Program and must bill the Arkansas 20 Medicaid Program for all covered services for eligible individuals. 21 Services which are covered by the Arkansas State Medicaid Program, or 22 underincluding the Alternative Community Services Waiver Program 23 (ACS) Provider-Led Arkansas Shared Savings Entity (PASSE) model, will be 24 utilized to the maximum extent possible for any individual who is eligible 25 for Medicaid coverage. It is the intent of this section that DDS, as a general policy, maximize the use of Medicaid funding available for 26 27 appropriate services. 28 Licensed private community providers The State shall require each provider 29 funded from thisthese Aappropriations for community based services, shall: 30 including funding from the Grants/Patient Services Line, in the Developmental 31 Disabilities Services - Operations appropriation, or from the Grants to 32 Community Providers Line, in the Developmental Disabilities Services 33 Grants-in-Aid appropriation, 34 1. to sScreen each individual to whom services are provided for a

- 11 It is the intent of this section to insure that wherever possible and
- 12 appropriate, Medicaid funds are utilized for covered or waivered services to

- 14 or the ACS Waiver.
- Nothing in this Act shall prevent the Division or any provider from
- 16 extending emergency services when appropriate measures have been taken in a
- 17 timely manner to secure Medicaid eligibility.
- The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2018

- 21 SECTION 12. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
- 22 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.
- 23 DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES VOCATIONAL TRAINEES. The Division of
- 24 Developmental Disabilities Services of the Department of Human Services is
- 25 hereby authorized to provide employment opportunities for people with
- 26 developmental disabilities residing at the Human Development Centers who work
- 27 at less than a competitive employment level.
- The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2018
- 29 <u>2019</u> through June 30, <del>2019</del> <u>2020</u>.

- 31 SECTION 13. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
- 32 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.
- 33 DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES TIMBER SALES PROCEEDS CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS AND
- 34 EQUIPMENT. The Division of Developmental Disabilities Services is authorized
- 35 to use the administrative operating accounts for capital improvements to
- 36 physical plants and for the purchase of capital equipment. The funds shall be

- 1 held by the Department of Human Services Division of Developmental
- 2 Disabilities Services from the proceeds of the sale of timber that may be
- 3 harvested from land owned by the Division of Developmental Disabilities
- 4 Services. All funds deposited and all expenses shall be tracked separately.
- 5 The harvesting of timber is specifically authorized to provide funds to
- 6 finance capital improvements to the physical plants and for the purchase of
- 7 major capital equipment.
- 8 The Division of Developmental Disabilities Services shall report all
- 9 income derived from timber management to the Chief Fiscal Officer of the
- 10 State and the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee. Any
- ll contracts initiated for the harvesting of timber shall be submitted to the
- 12 Review Subcommittee of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget
- 13 Committee for prior review. All expenditures of funds derived from the sale
- 14 of timber will be expended in accordance with relevant state purchasing laws.

- 18 SECTION 14. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 19 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. HUMAN
- 20 DEVELOPMENT CENTERS AND COMMUNITY PROVIDERS.
- 21 (A) The Developmental Disabilities Services Board or the Department of
- 22 Human Services shall not close any of the state administered Human
- 23 Development Centers which are located at Conway, Arkadelphia, Jonesboro,
- 24 Booneville, and Warren.
- 25 (B) The Department of Human Services shall continue to accept clients for
- 26 whom it has determined that therapy and residential services are needed at
- 27 state administered Human Development Centers and Community Programs licensed
- 28 by DDS shall continue to accept clients for whom it has been determined in
- 29 accordance with federal law that are in need of services in the community.
- 30 (C) Except for use as federal matching funds, no funds for community based
- 31 services licensed by DDS shall be transferred from Grants to Community
- 32 Providers line item of the Developmental Disabilities Services Grants-in-
- 33 Aid appropriation unless the transfer(s) directly benefit(s) community based
- 34 services for persons with developmental disabilities or from the
- 35 appropriation for the Human Development Centers unless the transfer(s)
- 36 directly benefit(s) the Human Development Centers.

- 1 (D) Nor shall any general revenue funding as of July 1,  $\frac{2018}{2019}$  from the
- 2 Grants to Community Providers line item of the Developmental Disabilities
- 3 Services Grants-in-Aid appropriation for persons with developmental
- 4 disabilities or from any other general revenues as of July 1,  $\frac{2018}{2019}$ ,
- 5 applied as federal matching funds for community based services licensed by
- 6 DDS on July 1, 2018 2019 be reduced below the approved funding level on July
- 7 1, 2018 2019; nor shall the general revenues applied as federal matching
- 8 funds for the Human Development Centers be reduced below the approved funding
- 9 level on July 1, <del>2018</del> <u>2019</u>.
- 10 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2018
- 11 <u>2019</u> through June 30, <del>2019</del> <u>2020</u>.

- 13 SECTION 15. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
- 14 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.
- 15 <u>ELIMINATION OF AUTISM WAIVER SERVICES WAITING LIST. Immediately upon the</u>
- 16 effective date of this Act, the Department of Human Services Division of
- 17 <u>Developmental Disabilities Services shall budget, allocate, and expend up to</u>
- 000 one million dollars (\$1,000,000) for the elimination of the Autism Waiver
- 19 <u>Services Program waiting list.</u>
- The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1,
- 21 2019 through June 30, 2020.

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- 23 SECTION 16. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
- 24 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
- 25 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
- 26 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
- 27 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
- 28 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
- 29 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
- 30 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
- 31 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

- 33 SECTION 17. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
- 34 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
- 35 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
- 36 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive

1	Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
2	manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
3	summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
4	Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

6	SECTION 18. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
7	General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits
8	the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
9	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2019 is essential to the operation of
10	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
11	the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
12	effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2019 could work irreparable harm
13	upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
14	programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
15	being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
16	and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2019.
