9	hundred fifty dollars (\$3,250) multiplied by the number of students enrolled	
10	in a secondary vocational area center during the previous school year

12	aid for each full-time equivalent student, as defined by the Department of	
13	Career Education.	
14	(b) The vocational center aid under

18	(ii) Funding for students in secondary vocational

32	center aid from the Public School Fund according to rules and regulations
