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20	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANS	AS:
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22	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 11, Chapter 10, Subcha	pter 3, is
23	amended to add an additional section to read as follows:	
24	11-10-302. Criminal background checks.	
25	(a) The Director of the Department of Workforce Servi	<u>ces shall</u>
26	establish a criminal background investigation policy for the	Department of
27	Workforce Services.	
28	(b)(1) An employee of the Department of Workforce Ser	vices or of a
29	contractor of the Department of Workforce Services who may b	e authorized by
30	the Director of the Department of Workforce Services to acce	<u>ss or view</u>
31	federal tax information as part of the employee's job duties	shall authorize:
32	(A) The Director of the Department of Wor	<u>kforce Services</u>
33	or his or her designee to obtain a state and federal crimina	<u>l background</u>
34	check at the expense of the Department of Workforce Services	; and
35	(B) The release of the criminal backgroun	<u>d check results</u>
36	to the Director of the Department of Workforce Services or h	<u>is or her</u>

2	(2) The employee of the Department of Workforce Services or of a
3	contractor of the Department of Workforce Services shall be subject to the
4	policy established under subsection (a) of this section that shall include:
5	(A) A criminal background check to be conducted by the
6	Identification Bureau of the Department of Arkansas State Police and the
7	Federal Bureau of Investigation that includes the taking of fingerprints;
8	(B) A criminal background check that satisfies the
9	background investigation standards established by the Internal Revenue
10	Service with regard to access to federal tax information;
11	(C) A criminal background check to be performed at least
12	one (1) time every ten (10) years;
13	(D) The Identification Bureau of the Department of
14	Arkansas State Police required to forward to the Director of the Department
15	of Workforce Services or his or her designee all information obtained as a
16	result of the criminal background check;
17	(E) Information received from a criminal background check
18	to be used only for the purpose of making decisions regarding the retention
19	of an employee in a position in which access to federal tax information may
20	be authorized;
21	(F) Information received by the Director of the Department
22	of Workforce Services or his or her designee from the Identification Bureau
23	of the Department of Arkansas State Police under subdivision (b)(2)(D) of
24	this section not to be released to any party other than the employee or his
25	or her authorized representative; and
26	(G)(i) An employee who is employed by the Department of
27	Workforce Services or by a contractor of the Department of Workforce Services
28	required to notify the Director of the Department of Workforce Services or
29	his or her designee of an arrest for a misdemeanor or felony offense within
30	twenty-four hours of the arrest.
31	(ii) Any information received under subdivision
32	(b)(2)(G)(i) of this section shall be used only for the purpose of the
33	Director of the Department of Workforce Services making a decision regarding
34	retention of an employee following the arrest.
35	(iii) Failure to provide notice of a subsequent
36	arrest under subdivision (b)(2)(G)(i) of this section is sufficient grounds

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1	for immediate termination of the employee's employment or other action as the
2	Director of the Department of Workforce Services or his or her designee deems
3	appropriate.
4	(c)(l) An applicant for employment with the Department of Workforce
5	Services or with a contractor of the Department of Workforce Services who may
6	be authorized by the Director of the Department of Workforce Services to
7	access or view federal tax information as part of the applicant's job duties
8	shall authorize:
9	(A) The Director of the Department of Workforce Services
10	or his or her designee to obtain a state and federal criminal background
11	check at the expense of the Department of Workforce Services; and
12	(B) The release of the criminal background check results
13	to the Director of the Department of Workforce Services or his or her
14	designee.
15	(2) An applicant shall be subject to the policy established
16	under subsection (a) of this section that shall include:
17	(A) A criminal background check to be conducted by the
18	Identification Bureau of the Department of Arkansas State Police and the
19	Federal Bureau of Investigation that includes the taking of fingerprints;
20	(B) A criminal background check that satisfies the
21	background investigation standards established by the Internal Revenue
22	Service with regard to access to federal tax information;
23	(C) A criminal background check required to be performed
24	before the applicant is employed and granted access to federal tax
25	information and continued employment conditioned upon favorable information
26	received from the criminal background check;
27	(D) The Identification Bureau of the Department of
28	Arkansas State Police required to forward to the Director of the Department
29	of Workforce Services or his or her designee all information obtained as a
30	result of the criminal background check;
31	(E) Information received from a criminal background check
32	to be used only for the purpose of making decisions regarding the employment
33	of an applicant in a position in which access to federal tax information may
34	or will be authorized; and
35	(F) Information received by the Director of the Department
36	of Workforce Services or his or her designee from the Identification Bureau

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1	of the Department of Arkansas State Police under subdivision (c)(2)(D) of
2	this section not to be released to any party other than the affected person
3	or his or her authorized representative.
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5	SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
6	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that certain employees and
7	contractors of the Department of Workforce Services have access to
8	confidential federal income tax information without having undergone a proper
9	criminal background investigation; that to protect certain financial
10	information, any individual that has access to confidential federal income
11	tax information should have appropriate clearance; and that this act is
12	immediately necessary because the Department of Workforce Services must
13	conform with federal laws and regulations regarding confidential federal
14	income tax information. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist, and
15	this act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public
16	peace, health, and safety shall become effective on:
17	(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;
18	(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,
19	the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the
20	bill; or
21	(3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is
22	overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.
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
