4	(2) "Immediate hazard" means a vehicle approaching a person		
5	operating a bicycle at a proximity and rate of speed sufficient to indicate		
6	to a reasonably careful person would that there is a danger of collision or		
7	accident.		
8			
9	27-51-1802. Rights and duties.		
10	A person operating a bicycle has the rights and duties applicable to a		
11	driver of a vehicle, unless:		
12	(1) A provision of this subchapter alters a right or duty; or		
13	(2) A right or duty applicable to a driver of a vehicle cannot		
14	by its nature apply to a person operating a bicycle.		
15			
16	27-51-1803. Entering stop or yield intersection.		
17	(a)(l) A person operating a bicycle approaching a stop sign shall:		
18	(A) Slow down;		
19	(B) If required to avoid an immediate hazard, stop at the		
20	stop sign before entering the intersection; and		
21	(C) Cautiously enter the intersection and yield the right-		
22	of-way to pedestrians lawfully within an adjacent crosswalk and to other		
23	traffic lawfully using the intersection.		
24	(2) If a person operating a bicycle meets the requirements		
25	provided in subdivision (a)(l) of this section, he or she may cautiously make		
26	a right or left turn, or proceed through the intersection without stopping at		
27	the stop sign.		
28	(b)(l) A person operating a bicycle approaching a steady red traffic		
29	control light shall:		
30	(A) Make a complete stop at the steady red traffic control		
31	light before entering the intersection; and		
32	(B) Yield the right-of-way to all oncoming traffic that		
33	constitutes an immediate hazard during the time that he or she is moving		
34	across or within the intersection.		
35	(2) If a person operating a bicycle meets the requirements as		
36	provided in subdivision (b)(1) of this section, he or she may proceed through

1	the steady red traffic control light with caution.		
2	(3) However, a person operating a bicycle may make a:		
3	(A) Right-hand turn at a steady red traffic control light		
4	without stopping after slowing to a reasonable speed and yielding the right-		
5	of-way, if required, to oncoming traffic that constitutes an immediate		
6	hazard; or		
7	(B) Left-hand turn onto a one-way road at a steady red		
8	traffic control light after stopping and yielding to oncoming traffic that		
9	constitutes an immediate hazard.

11	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 27-49-111 is amended to read as follows.		
12	27-49-111. Use of bicycles, electric bicycles, or animals.		
13	Every person riding a bicycle, electric bicycle, or an animal, or		
14	driving any animal drawing a vehicle upon a highway, shall have all the		
15	rights and all of the duties applicable to the driver of a vehicle, except		
16	those provisions of this act which by their nature can have no applicability.		
17	A person riding an animal or driving any animal drawing a vehicle upon		
18	a highway has the rights and duties applicable to a driver of a vehicle.
