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36	SECTION 2. Arka	ansas Code § 15-20-1103, concerning	definitions used in

- the Arkansas Soil Nutrient Application and Poultry Litter Utilization Act, is amended to add additional subdivisions to read as follows:
- 3 (19) "Confined livestock feeding operation" means a lot or facility
 4 where livestock, fowl, or other animals have been, are, or will be stabled or
 5 confined and fed or maintained and where crops, vegetation, forage growth, or
 6 post-harvest residues are not sustained in the normal growing season over
 7 significant portions of the lot or facility;
- 8 (20) "Liquid livestock litter management plan" means a plan for the
 9 utilization of litter generated by a liquid livestock litter management
 10 system; and
- 11 (21) "Liquid livestock litter management system" means a system used
 12 for the collection, storage, distribution, or disposal of livestock litter in
 13 liquid form that is generated by a confined livestock feeding operation.

SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 15-20-1114 is amended to read as follows: 15-20-1114. No conflict with Arkansas Water and Air Pollution Control 17 Act.

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- (a)(1) This subchapter shall not supersede the requirement that liquid animal waste management systems comply with the Arkansas Water and Air Pollution Control Act, § 8-4-101 et seq., or regulations adopted under the Arkansas Water and Air Pollution Control Act, § 8-4-101 et seq.
- (2) This subchapter shall not supersede the requirements of the Arkansas Water and Air Pollution Control Act, § 8-4-101 et seq., for waste disposal systems utilizing land application as a part of the waste disposal process.
- (b) Except as provided in subsection (a) of this section, nutrient and litter management activities conducted in compliance with this subchapter shall not be subject to regulation under the Arkansas Water and Air Pollution Control Act, § 8-4-101 et seq., or regulations adopted under the Arkansas Water and Air Pollution Control Act, § 8-4-101 et seq.
- 31 (c)(1) The Arkansas Natural Resources Commission may determine that
 32 certain nutrient and litter-management activities regulated under the
 33 provisions of this subchapter are not in compliance with the subchapter and
 34 thus constitute placing sewage, industrial waste, or other wastes in a
 35 location where it is likely to cause pollution to the waters within the
 36 state.

5	(3) Upon a request by the commission, the Arkansas Department of		
6	Environmental Quality shall provide technical assistance to the commission		
7	related to permitting a facility affected by subdivision (c)(1) of this

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10	SECTION 4. Arkansas Code Title 15, Chapter 20, Subchapter 11, is		
11	amended to add additional sections to read as follows:		
12	15-20-1115. Liquid Livestock Litter Utilization.		
13	(a)(l) A confined livestock feeding operation utilizing a liquid		
14	livestock litter management system shall develop and implement a liquid		
15	livestock litter management plan that is acceptable to the Arkansas Natural		
16	Resources Commission.		
17	(2) A person that intends to develop a liquid livestock litter		
18	management plan shall obtain certification from the commission under § 15-20-		
19	1004 before developing the liquid livestock litter management plan.		
20	(3) The liquid livestock litter management plan is a part of the		
21	nutrient management plan of the confined livestock feeding operation.		
22	(b) The liquid livestock litter management plan shall include without		
23	limitation a:		
24	(1) Periodic liquid livestock litter nutrient content analysis		
25	<pre>component;</pre>		
26	(2) Liquid livestock litter utilization component providing for		
27	the proper utilization of the litter produced, including without limitation		
28	provisions ensuring that:		
29	(A) Land application is at a rate not to exceed the		
30	protective rates determined by the Arkansas Phosphorus Index; and		
31	(B) Litter not applied to land is converted to a		
32	nonnutrient use or other use acceptable to the commission; and		
33	(3) Records component requiring the owner of the confined		
34	livestock feeding operation to maintain sufficient records at the site of the		
35	confined livestock feeding operation to determine liquid livestock litter		
36	utilization and compliance with the other components of the liquid livestock		

T	litter management plan.		
2	(c)(1) A liquid livestock litter management plan is subject to		
3	approval by the board of directors of the conservation district where the		
4	majority of the land to which the liquid livestock litter management plan		
5	applies is located.		
6	(2) A person requesting to implement a liquid livestock litter		
7	management plan may appeal the board's disapproval of the liquid livestock		
8	litter management plan or a provision of the liquid livestock litter		
9	management plan to the Executive Director of the Arkansas Natural Resources		
10	Commission.		
11	(d) An approved liquid livestock litter management plan constitutes a		
12	permit to apply nutrients consistent with the liquid livestock litter		
13	management plan.		
14	(e) The commission shall promulgate rules necessary to implement this		
15	section.		
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17	15-20-1116. Liquid livestock waste system permits.		
18	(a)(1) When an application for the issuance of a new permit for a		
19	liquid livestock waste system or a modification to an existing permit for a		
20	liquid livestock waste system is filed, the Arkansas Natural Resources		
21	Commission shall give notice of its proposed action within one hundred twenty		
22	(120) days of receipt of the application.		
23	(2)(A) At the conclusion of the public comment period, the		
24	commission shall announce in writing within sixty (60) days its final		
25	decision regarding the permit application.		
26	(B) For a modification that the commission considers to be		
27	minor, the Arkansas Department of Environmental Quality shall make its final		
28	decision regarding the permit application within thirty (30) days after		
29	receipt of the application.		
30	(3) An applicant may waive in writing to the commission the		
31	notification period requirements under this section.		
32	(b)(l) The commission shall begin accepting applications under		
33	subsection (a) of this section no later than January 1, 2021.		
34	(2) On or before January 1, 2021, all active permits issued by		
35	the department shall be transferred to the commission without modification.		
36	(3) An application submitted to the department prior to January		

1	1, 2021, Shall remain with the department until the permit is approved of
2	disapproved.
3	(c) The commission shall promulgate rules necessary to implement this
4	section.
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6	SECTION 5. TEMPORARY LANGUAGE. DO NOT CODIFY.
7	(a) The Arkansas Natural Resources Commission shall promulgate rules
8	necessary to implement §§ 15-20-1115 and 15-20-1116.
9	(b)(1) When adopting the initial rules to implement §§ 15-20-1115 and
10	15-20-1116, the final rule shall be filed with the Secretary of State for
11	adoption under § 25-15-204(f):
12	(A) On or before July 1, 2020; or
13	(B) If approval under § 10-3-309 has not occurred by July
14	1, 2020, as soon as practicable after approval under § 10-3-309.
15	(2) The commission shall file the proposed rule with the
16	Legislative Council under § 10-3-309(c) sufficiently in advance of July 1,
17	2020, so that the Legislative Council may consider the rule for approval
18	before July 1, 2020.
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
