SECTION 9. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 8 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. COST OF 9 10 LIVING INCREASES. Employees of the Bureau of Legislative Research assigned 11 to positions having a labor grade shall be eligible for cost-of-living 12 increases on July 1, in an amount equal to that granted to all other state 13 agency, board, commission or institution of higher education employees on 14 those dates. Any additional adjustments in annual salary rates for Bureau 15 employees, labor market adjustments, merit pay adjustments or employee 16 retention or recruitment requirements shall be made at the discretion of the 17 Director of the Bureau. 24 SECTION 10. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 25 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 26 DISBURSING OFFICER. The Director of the Bureau of Legislative Research of the 27 Legislative Council shall be the disbursing officer for the funds 28 appropriated by this Act, including the Interim Committee Study Expenses. The 29 Director shall appoint a designee who shall serve as the disbursing officer 30 in his/her absence. The Bureau of Legislative Research may utilize, 5 at the discretion of the Director of the Bureau of Legislative Research, the 6 following classifications as necessary. The use of these classifications 7 shall not be considered as increasing the number of positions authorized in 8 this act, only as a temporary reclassification or cross grade of a position. 9

3	SECTION 12. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
4	authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
5	and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
6	the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
7	Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
8	Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
9	control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
10	the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
11	strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.
12	
13	SECTION 13. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
14	Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
15	contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
16	which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
17	Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
18	manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
19	summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
20	Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
21	
22	SECTION 14. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
23	General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits
24	the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
25	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2019 is essential to the operation of
26	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
27	the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
28	effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2019 could work irreparable harm
29	upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
30	programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
31	being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
32	and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2019.
