1 SECTION 16. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
2 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CARRY
3 FORWARD - NEW HIRE REGISTRY. Any balance in the funds made available by this
4 Act for the New Hire Registry which remain on June 30, ~~2019~~ 2020, may be
5 carried forward into the next fiscal year, to be used for the same purpose.

6 Any carry forward of unexpended balance of funding as authorized herein,
7 may be carried forward under the following conditions:

8 (1) Prior to June 30, ~~2019~~ 2020 the Agency shall by written statement
9 set forth its reason(s) for the need to carry forward said funding to the
10 Department of Finance and Administration Office of Budget;

11 (2) The Department of Finance and Administration Office of Budget shall
12 report to the Arkansas Legislative Council all amounts carried forward by the
13 September Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee meeting
14 which report shall include the name of the Agency, Board, Commission or
15 Institution and the amount of the funding carried forward, the program name
16 or line item, the funding source of that appropriation and a copy of the
17 written request set forth in (1) above;

18 (3) Each Agency, Board, Commission or Institution shall provide a
19 written report to the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee
20 containing all information set forth in item (2) above, along with a written
21 statement as to the current status of the project, contract, purpose etc. for
22 which the carry forward was originally requested no later than thirty (30)
23 days prior to the time the Agency, Board, Commission or Institution presents
24 its budget request to the Arkansas Legislative Council/Joint Budget
25 Committee; and

26 (4) Thereupon, the Department of Finance and Administration shall
27 include all information obtained in item (3) above in the budget manuals
28 and/or a statement of non-compliance by the Agency, Board, Commission or
29 Institution.

33 SECTION 17. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
34 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. EXTRA
35 HELP. There is hereby authorized, for the Department of Workforce Services
36 for the ~~2018-2019~~ 2019-2020 fiscal year, the following maximum number of

1 part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from
2 funds appropriated herein for such purposes: three hundred eighty (380)
3 temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed
4 those provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its
5 successor, for the appropriate classification. Any of these positions
6 utilized in a manner which are funded by federal sources are specifically
7 exempt from limitation of hours, either by Act or Regulation.

8 In order to comply with the timeliness requirements set forth by the
9 Social Security Act, the Chairman of the Board of Review is authorized to
10 utilize part-time or temporary employees from the pool of positions provided
11 to the Department of Workforce Services in any occurrence where the number of
12 appeals to the Board of Review or Appeal Tribunal increases above a level
13 that can be resolved by the permanent staff in a timely manner. The
14 Department of Workforce services will determine the appropriate funding
15 source within the Department for said positions.

16 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2018~~
17 2019 through June 30, ~~2019~~ 2020.

19 SECTION 18. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
20 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. "REED ACT
21 FUNDS". Funds received by the State may be used as specified in Section 903
22 of the Social Security Act, for the purpose of construction and improvement
23 of buildings, rent/lease costs, acquisition of land, the payment of salaries
24 and related benefits of central and local office staff, maintenance and
25 operation of central and local offices, payment of unemployment insurance
26 benefits, or as otherwise prescribed in Section 903 of the Social Security
27 Act, as amended.

28 The amount obligated pursuant to this Act shall not exceed the amount by
29 which (a) the aggregate of the amounts transferred to the account of this
30 State pursuant to Section 903 of the Social Security Act exceeds (b) the
31 aggregate of the amounts used by this State and charged against the amounts
32 transferred to the account of this State.

33 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2018~~
34 2019 through June 30, ~~2019~~ 2020.

35
36 SECTION 19. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS

1 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.

2 ADDITIONAL POSITIONS. The Director of the Department of Workforce Services,
3 after receiving the approval of the Office of Personnel Management, and after
4 seeking the prior review by the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget
5 Committee, shall have the authority to establish such new or additional full
6 time positions as may become necessary to carry out the objectives of the
7 program and/or to meet Federal requirements of new and/or expanded programs
8 where such needs are financed by federal funds; provided that not more than
9 two hundred persons may be employed in addition to those authorized in the
10 salary schedule and that the rate of pay shall not exceed those set out in
11 the salary schedule for comparable positions as authorized under the
12 provisions of the Regular Salaries section of this Act.

13 If the agency requests continuation of a "Growth Pool" position(s) as
14 established herein, the position(s) must be requested as a new position(s) in
15 the agency's budget request.

16 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2018~~
17 2019 through June 30, ~~2019~~ 2020.

18
19 SECTION 20. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
20 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER
21 OF APPROPRIATION. Subject to such rules and regulations as may be
22 implemented by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and after having sought
23 the prior approval by the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget
24 Committee, the Director of the Department of Workforce Services is hereby
25 authorized to make transfers from any appropriation made by this Act to any
26 other appropriation made by this Act with the exception of the "Reed Act
27 Funds" appropriations set forth in the Reed Act Funds appropriation section
28 of this Act, and of the appropriation made for Regular Salaries or
29 Maintenance and General Operation. Such transfers may be made whenever it
30 appears, by projecting the expenditures of any of the appropriations in this
31 Act, that there will be a deficiency of appropriation in one item and that
32 there will be a corresponding excess of appropriation in another item or
33 items which may be transferred. The transfer of appropriation shall be
34 effected only on approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State. Provided,
35 however, that no transfer of appropriations may be authorized to increase the
36 total amount appropriated for Regular Salaries, or Maintenance and General

1 Operations, except as may be authorized elsewhere by law.

2 Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of
3 appropriation and general revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year
4 is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by
5 delineating such maximums in the appropriation act(s) for a state agency and
6 the general revenue allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by
7 amendment to the Revenue Stabilization law. Further, the General Assembly
8 has determined that the Department of Workforce Services may operate more
9 efficiently if some flexibility is provided to the Department of Workforce
10 Services authorizing broad powers under this Section. Therefore, it is both
11 necessary and appropriate that the General Assembly maintain oversight by
12 requiring prior approval of the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee
13 as provided by this section. The requirement of approval by the Legislative
14 Council or Joint Budget Committee is not a severable part of this section.
15 If the requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint Budget
16 Committee is ruled unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction,
17 this entire section is void.

18 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2018~~
19 2019 through June 30, ~~2019~~ 2020.

20
21 SECTION 21. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
22 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. INTER-
23 AGENCY TRANSFER OF STATE GENERAL REVENUE FOR THE TEMPORARY ASSISTANCE FOR
24 NEEDEY FAMILIES (TANF) PROGRAMS. Upon the request of the Director of the
25 Department of Human Services (DHS) and the Director of the Department of
26 Workforce Services (DWS), the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State may approve
27 up to three million six hundred forty thousand six hundred fifty dollars
28 (\$3,640,650) each fiscal year in State General Revenue appropriated to DWS
29 for the TANF program to be transferred to the DHS - Division of County
30 Operations in support of Arkansas' TANF Programs or any related separate
31 state programs.

32 The Director of the Department of Workforce Services shall provide a
33 report of all transfers made to the DHS - Division of County Operations to
34 the Performance Evaluation and Expenditure Review Committee of the Arkansas
35 Legislative Council and Joint Budget Committee. The report must include the
36 justification for and the amount of the completed transfers.

1 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2018~~
2 2019 through June 30, ~~2019~~ 2020.

3
4 SECTION 22. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
5 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER
6 OF TANF BLOCK GRANT FUNDS. Each fiscal year, the Department of Workforce
7 Services shall transfer the sum of seven million five hundred thousand
8 dollars (\$7,500,000) from the state's federal Temporary Assistance for Needy
9 Families block grant to the Department of Education Public School Fund
10 Account to be used solely for the Arkansas Better Chance Program.

11 If the state match for the Temporary Assistance for Needy Families grant
12 or the state's Temporary Assistance for Needy Families grant is reduced, the
13 amount to be transferred may be adjusted in proportion to the percentage
14 change in the state match or the state's Temporary Assistance for Needy
15 Families grant. The amount to be transferred may also be reduced
16 proportionately if new cost requirements are imposed upon the state as a
17 result of new or revised Temporary Assistance for Needy Families regulations
18 at the federal level.

19 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2018~~
20 2019 through June 30, ~~2019~~ 2020.

21
22 SECTION 23. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
23 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRAINING
24 TRUST FUND TRANSFER. Immediately upon the effective date of this Act, the
25 Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall transfer on his or her books and
26 those of the State Treasurer and the Auditor of the State the sum of two
27 million five hundred thousand dollars (\$2,500,000) from the Department of
28 Workforce Services Training Trust Fund to the Skills Development Fund.

29 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2018~~
30 2019 through June 30, ~~2019~~ 2020.

31
32 SECTION 24. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
33 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.
34 RESTRICTIONS ON FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE UNDER THE TEMPORARY ASSISTANCE FOR NEEDY
35 FAMILIES PROGRAM.

36 (a)(1) Determining the maximum number of employees, the maximum amount

1 of appropriation, for what purposes an appropriation is authorized, and
 2 general revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year is the
 3 prerogative of the General Assembly.

4 (2) The purposes of subsection (a) of this section are typically
 5 accomplished by:

6 (A) Identifying the purpose in the appropriation act;

7 (B) Delineating such maximums in the appropriation act for
 8 a state agency; and

9 (C) Delineating the general revenue allocations authorized
 10 for each fund and fund account by amendment to the revenue stabilization law.

11 (3) It is both necessary and appropriate that the General
 12 Assembly restrict the use of appropriations authorized in this act.

13 (b)(1) Upon the request of the Governor or the General Assembly, the
 14 Department of Workforce Services shall request a waiver from the federal
 15 government to:

16 (A) Restrict the financial assistance granted to a
 17 recipient of the Temporary Assistance for Needy Families Program or its
 18 successor program to purchase goods and services that are considered
 19 essential and necessary for the welfare of the family, including without
 20 limitation:

21 (i) Food;

22 (ii) Clothing;

23 (iii) Housing;

24 (iv) Utilities;

25 (v) Child care; and

26 (vi) Incidentals, including without limitation
 27 transportation and medicine or medical supplies or equipment not covered by
 28 either the Arkansas Medicaid Program or the health benefit plan of the
 29 individual; and

30 (b) Restrict the cash withdrawal from an electronic
 31 benefit transfer card account that receives financial assistance under the
 32 Temporary Assistance for Needy Families Program or its successor program by
 33 electronic benefit transfer system.

34 (2) If the federal government denies the waiver application,
 35 this section shall not be implemented.

36 (3) If the department does not request a wavier under

1 subdivision (b)(1) of this section, the department shall not allocate,
2 budget, expend, or utilize appropriations under this act for the
3 participation of persons in the Temporary Assistance for Needy Families
4 Program.

5 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2018
6 2019 through June 30, ~~2019~~ 2020.

7
8 SECTION 25. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
9 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
10 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
11 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
12 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
13 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
14 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
15 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
16 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

17
18 SECTION 26. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
19 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
20 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
21 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
22 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
23 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
24 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
25 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

26
27 SECTION 27. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
28 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits
29 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
30 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2019 is essential to the operation of
31 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
32 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
33 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2019 could work irreparable harm
34 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
35 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
36 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health

and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2019.

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
