10	subsection to read as follows:

12	(1) "Construction personnel" means employees of the Arkansas		
13	Department of Transportation or the counties or the municipalities of this		
14	state or any contractors of the State Highway Commission or the counties or		
15	municipalities;		
16	(2) "Highway work zone" means any area upon or adjacent to any		
17	highway, road, or street of this state where construction, reconstruction,		
18	maintenance, or any other type of work is being performed or is in progress		
19	by employees of the Arkansas Department of Transportation, the counties or		
20	the municipalities of this state, or any contractors of the State Highway		
21	Commission or the counties or municipalities; and		
22	(3) "Law enforcement officer" means any member of the Division		
23	of Arkansas State Police or the Arkansas Highway Police Division of the		
24	Arkansas Department of Transportation and any other certified law enforcement

28	SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 27-52-111(c), concerning the use of an		
29	automated enforcement device operated by a county government or department		
30	state government operating within the boundaries of a municipality, is		
31	amended to read as follows:		
32	(c)(1) A municipality or a department of state government that is		
33	operating within the boundaries of the municipality may use an automated		
34	enforcement device to detect and enforce a violation of traffic laws or		
35	ordinances:		
36	(A) In a school zone; or		

1	(B) At a railroad crossing.		
2	(2) A law enforcement officer of the Arkansas Highway Police		
3	Division of the Arkansas Department of Transportation who is operating within		
4	the boundaries of the municipality may use an automated enforcement device to		
5	detect and enforce a violation of traffic laws or ordinances in a highway		
6	work zone when construction personnel are present in the highway work zone.		
7	(3) If a municipality or a department of state government that		
8	is operating within the boundaries of the municipality uses an automated		
9	enforcement device, then a certified law enforcement officer must <u>shall</u> :		
10	(A) Be present with the automated enforcement device; and		
11	(B) Issue the citation to the violator at the time and		
12	place of the violation.

14	SECTION 4. Arkansas Code § 27-52-111, concerning the use of an		
15	automated enforcement device operated by a county government or department of		
16	state government within the boundaries of a municipality, is amended to add		
17	an additional subsection to read as follows:		
18	(e) As used in this section:		
19	(1) "Construction personnel" means employees of the Arkansas		
20	Department of Transportation or the counties or the municipalities of this		
21	state or any contractors of the State Highway Commission or the counties or		
22	municipalities;		
23	(2) "Highway work zone" means any area upon or adjacent to any		
24	highway, road, or street of this state where construction, reconstruction,		
25	maintenance, or any other type of work is being performed or is in progress		
26	by employees of the Arkansas Department of Transportation, the counties or		
27	the municipalities of this state, or any contractors of the State Highway		
28	Commission or the counties or municipalities; and		
29	(3) "Law enforcement officer" means any member of the Division		
30	of Arkansas State Police or the Arkansas Highway Police Division of the		
31	Arkansas Department of Transportation and any other certified law enforcement		
32	officer employed full time by the State of Arkansas or any political		
33	subdivision of the State of Arkansas or court personnel in Arkansas.
