2	SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the		
3	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that there may be confusion over		
4	which entity controls a public school district; and that this act is		
5	necessary in order to clarify the conditions under which a public school		
6	district may reassume autonomy after being under the authority of the State		
7	Board of Education. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist, and this		
8	act being necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and		
9	safety shall become effective within sixty (60) days of the passage of this		
10	act and not later than June 30, 2021.
