8 AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PREGNANCY HELP
9 ORGANIZATION GRANTS FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND
10 ADMINISTRATION - DISBURSING OFFICER FOR THE FISCAL
11 YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 2024; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

14 AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND

16 APPROPRIATION FOR THE 2023-2024 FISCAL
17 YEAR.
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21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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23 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION - PREGNANCY HELP ORGANIZATION GRANTS. There
24 is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Finance and Administration -
25 Disbursing Officer, to be payable from the Pregnancy Help Organization Sub-
26 Fund in the Miscellaneous Agencies Fund Account, for grants for the Pregnancy
27 Help Organizations for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2024, the following:

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33 SECTION 2. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
34 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. PREGNANCY
35 HELP ORGANIZATION GRANTS.

36 (a)(1) As used in this section, "pregnancy help organization" means an



1 organization existing as of January 1, 2023, that:

2 (A) Seeks to provide a range of services to individuals
3 facing an unintended pregnancy with the intention of encouraging pregnant
4 women to give birth to their unborn children; and

5 (B) Does not perform, prescribe, provide referrals for, or
6 encourage abortion or affiliate with any organization that performs,
7 prescribes, provides referrals for, or encourages abortion.

8 (2) As used in this section, a "pregnancy help organization"
9 includes without limitation:

10 (A) Organizations traditionally known as "crisis pregnancy
11 organizations";

12 (B) Maternity homes;

13 (C) Adoption agencies; and

14 (D) Social services agencies that provide material support
15 and other assistance to individuals facing an unintended pregnancy to help
16 those individuals give birth to their unborn children.

17 (b)(1) The Department of Finance and Administration shall create a
18 grant program to provide funding to pregnancy help organizations.

19 (2) Grant funds shall be disbursed directly to the pregnancy help
20 organizations from the Department of Finance and Administration.

21 (c)(1) The department shall promulgate rules to implement the
22 disbursement of the grant moneys from the Pregnancy Help Organization Grant
23 Sub-Fund in the Miscellaneous Agencies Fund Account.

24 (2) The rules shall include:

25 (A) A requirement that the entity requesting the grant
26 monies submit a plan describing how the entity will spend the grant moneys;
27 and

28 (B) A statement that the funds shall not be disbursed all
29 at once, but in increments in accordance with the plan described in
30 subdivision (c)(2)(A) of this section.

31 (d) The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July
32 1, ~~2022~~ 2023, through June 30, ~~2023~~ 2024.

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34 SECTION 3. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
35 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUNDING
36 TRANSFER. (i) Immediately upon the effective date of this Section, the Chief

1 Fiscal Officer of the State shall transfer on his or her books and those of
2 the State Treasurer and the Auditor of the State the sum of one million
3 dollars (\$1,000,000) from the General Revenue Allotment Reserve Fund to the
4 Pregnancy Help Organization Grant Sub-Fund in the Miscellaneous Agencies Fund
5 Account to provide funding exclusively for the Pregnancy Help Organization
6 Grants Appropriation in Section 1 in this Act to be distributed as set out in
7 Pregnancy Help Organization Grants Special Language in Section 2 of this Act.

8 (ii) Any funds not expended in the Pregnancy Help Organization Grant
9 Sub-Fund in the Miscellaneous Agencies Fund Account as established in
10 subsection (i) herein after June 30, ~~2023~~ 2024 shall be transferred to the
11 General Revenue Allotment Reserve Fund.

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13 SECTION 4. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
14 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
15 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
16 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
17 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
18 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
19 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
20 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
21 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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23 SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
24 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
25 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
26 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
27 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
28 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
29 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
30 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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32 SECTION 6. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
33 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
34 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
35 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2023 is essential to the operation of
36 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in

the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2023 could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2023.

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
