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6	SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. Section 1 of this act is effective for tax		
7	years beginning on or after January 1, 2023.		
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9	SECTION 3. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the		
10	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that the inflation rate is high,		
11	with the Consumer Price Index for All Items increasing six and five-tenths		
12	percent (6.5%) and the consumer price index for food items increasing ten and		
13	four-tenths percent (10.4%) over the last twelve (12) months according to the		
14	United States Bureau of Labor Statistics; that many people are in need of		
15	jobs in this economy; and that this act is immediately necessary to ensure		
16	that there is no lapse in the opportunity for major economic development		
17	projects to be completed because major economic development projects will		
18	bring hundreds of high-paying jobs to the state. Therefore, an emergency is		
19	declared to exist, and this act being immediately necessary for the		
20	preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall become effective		
21	on:		
22	(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;		
23	(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,		
24	the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the		
25	bill; or		
26	(3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is		
27	overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.		
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
