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SECTION 10. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER 31 32 OF TANF BLOCK GRANT FUNDS. Each fiscal year, the Department of Human 33 Services shall transfer the sum of seven million five hundred thousand 34 dollars (\$7,500,000) from the state's federal Temporary Assistance for Needy 35 Families block grant to the Department of Education Division of Elementary 36 and Secondary Education Public School Fund Account to be used solely for the

COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. 14	programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
15	being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
16	and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2024.
