TRANSFER 9 OF FUNDS FOR LOCAL JUVENILE DETENTION FACILITIES. SECTION 10. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 24 25 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 26 RESIDENTIAL SERVICES CONTINGENCY. If it has been determined that the 27 Department of Human Services - Division of Youth Services cannot continue to 28 contract with private provider(s) for residential juvenile services, 29 educational services, therapeutic services, and/or medical services and deems 30 it necessary to utilize Department staff to provide all or parts of the 31 required services above, the Department is authorized to seek the approval of 32 the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, the Governor and the Arkansas 33 Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee to utilize the contingent 34 residential services positions contained in this Act and to make the 35 appropriate transfers from any line item authorized in the RESIDENTIAL 36 SERVICES appropriation of this Act to any line item authorized in the

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1 OPERATIONS appropriation of this Act. If it has been determined that the 2 Department of Human Services - Division of Youth Services cannot continue to operate one or more of the various service components of a Residential 3 4 Facility for residential juvenile services, educational services, therapeutic 5 services, and/or medical services and deems it necessary to utilize a 6 contract with private provider(s), the Department is authorized to seek the 7 approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, the Governor and the 8 Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee to make the 9 appropriate transfers from any line item authorized in the OPERATIONS 10 appropriation of this Act to any line item authorized in the RESIDENTIAL 11 SERVICES appropriation of this Act.

15 SECTION 11. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 16 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. EXTRA HELP SALARIES - CONTINGENT RESIDENTIAL SERVICES POSITIONS. There is hereby 17 18 established for the Department of Human Services - Division of Youth Services 19 - Contingent Residential Services Positions, the following maximum number of 20 positions whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions of the Uniform 21 Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code § 21-5-201 et seq.), or 22 its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Requests to use positions 23 will be based upon the non-contracted services for residential juvenile 24 services, educational services, therapeutic services, and/or medical 25 services. If at such time a category(s) of services are contracted with 26 private provider(s), identified positions associated with such service(s) 27 shall be returned to the contingency pool. In order to ensure required 28 staffing levels, Extra Help positions authorized herein are specifically 29 exempt from limitation of hours, either by Act or regulation. 30

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SECTION 12. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds 5 6 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency 7 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and 8 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 9 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 10 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 11 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 12 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 13 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

14

15 SECTION 13. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General 16 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations 17 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for 18 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive 19 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget 20 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or 21 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative 22 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 23

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24 SECTION 14. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the 25 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits 26 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2024 is essential to the operation of 27 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in 28 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the 29 30 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2024 could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental 31 32 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act 33 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health 34 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2024. 35

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
