- 12 (4) Thereupon, the Department of Finance and Administration shall include
- 13 all information obtained in item (3) above in the budget manuals and/or a
- 14 statement of non-compliance by the Agency, Board, Commission or Institution.
- The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2023
- 16 2024 through June 30, 2024 2025.

- 18 SECTION 33. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
- 19 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. STIPENDS.
- 20 The University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences is hereby authorized to pay
- 21 stipends to students engaged in post-graduate clinical training in accredited
- 22 programs of the University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences, from "Regular
- 23 Salaries" or "Maintenance and General Operation", as follows:

- 35 SECTION 34. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
- 36 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.

- 1 ESTABLISHMENT OF A "GROWTH POOL". (a) The Arkansas Division of Higher
- 2 Education shall establish and maintain for the 2023-2024 2024-2025 fiscal
- 3 year a pool of three hundred (300) non-classified positions. A position
- 4 established under this section shall not exceed the salary rate of the
- 5 highest maximum annual salary rate authorized by the General Assembly in the
- 6 institution's appropriation act. These positions are to be used by the
- 7 University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences in the event that the personal
- 8 services needs of the University during the 2023 2024 2024-2025 fiscal year

- 15 SECTION 35. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
- 16 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CHILD
- 17 HEALTH AND FAMILY LIFE INSTITUTE. The Child Health and Family Life Institute
- 18 shall be administered under the direction of Arkansas Children's Hospital.
- 19 Arkansas Children's Hospital shall enter into a cooperative agreement and/or
- 20 contract with the University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences-Department of

Because the Rural Medical Practice Student Loan and Scholarship Program Loans and/or Scholarships and the Community Match Student Loan and Scholarship Program Loans and/or Scholarships have the goal of providing primary care physicians in rural Arkansas, transfers may be made in such amounts as are required between the line items made in the appropriation for "Medical Loans and Scholarships".

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2023 18 2024 through June 30, 2024 2025.

SECTION 38. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CLINICAL EXPANSION AND RESEARCH POOL. (a) In order to address personnel needs emerging from expanding medical research and patient care issues and the necessity of recruiting and retaining qualified medical, research, and related support personnel, the University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences or its successor is authorized for the 2023-2024 2024-2025 fiscal year a pool of seven hundred (700) "Clinical Expansion and Research Pool" positions. These positions are to be used by the University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences in the event that the personal services needs resulting from unanticipated clinical or research programs that are initiated during the 2023-2024 2024-2025 fiscal year require additional positions, either in title, in classification, or in number, that are not authorized or contemplated by the General Assembly in the Regular Salaries - Operations section of this Act.

(b) The University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences is authorized to access the "Clinical Expansion and Research Pool" positions authorized in this Section at any time during the fiscal year when it is determined by the

- 1 Chancellor of the University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences, subject to the
- 2 review and approval by the Board of Trustees, that the need for additional
- 3 positions exists. Only medical or research positions shall be established
- 4 under this provision. The Chancellor of the University of Arkansas for
- 5 Medical Sciences shall provide a quarterly report detailing the justification
- 6 of allocation of positions from this "Clinical Expansion and Research Pool"
- 7 to the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, to the Arkansas Division of Higher
- 8 Education, and to the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee
- 9 for review. The report shall also include an accounting of the names, titles

- 31 Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee is ruled unconstitutional by a
- 32 court of competent jurisdiction, this entire section is void.
- 33 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, $\frac{2023}{1}$
- 34 2024 through June 30, 2024 2025.

SECTION 39. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS

1 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. ABUSED 2 CHILDREN AND ADOLESCENTS SERVICES PROGRAM FUNDING PROVISION. In the event 3 the amount of general revenue distributed to the University of Arkansas 4 Medical Center Fund for the Department of Pediatrics and the Psychiatric 5 Research Institute each fiscal year is at least equal to the amount 6 distributed during the 2012-13 fiscal year, an amount not less than seven 7 hundred thousand dollars (\$700,000) shall be allocated and made available as 8 follows: four hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$450,000) each fiscal year 9 shall be made available exclusively to support the purposes and goals to 10 improve screening, monitoring and care for abused children and adolescents 11 through the Child Safety Centers or the University of Arkansas for Medical 12 Sciences as referred by the Child Safety Centers. Maintenance of statewide 13 screening and assessment protocols as well as evidence-based training of 14 mental health professionals are to be considered critical components of the 15 overall goals. For the provision of assessment and therapeutic services, 16 these funds are to be provided to the Child Safety Centers through contracts 17 from the University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences. The contracts will 18 stipulate the terms of the agreement and reporting requirements; an amount 19 not to exceed fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) may be utilized for 20 administrative costs as may be necessary to administer the program or if 21 determined not to be needed for administrative costs may be placed in reserve 22 for future needs of the program. The remaining two hundred thousand dollars 23 (\$200,000) shall be allocated and made available to the Department of 24 Pediatrics for expenses for medical examinations, consultation, education and 25 training as stipulated in the terms of agreement between the Chancellor of 26 the University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences and the Department of 27 Pediatrics. 28 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2023 29 2024 through June 30, 2024 2025. 30 SECTION 40. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds 31 32 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency 33 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and 34 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 35 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary

Procedures and Restrictions Act, the Higher Education Expenditure Restriction

1	Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where
2	applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and
3	Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in
4	disbursement of said funds.
5	
6	SECTION 41. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
7	Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
8	contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
9	which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
10	Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
11	manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
12	summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
13	Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
14	
15	SECTION 42. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
16	General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits
17	the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
18	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2024 is essential to the operation of
19	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
20	the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
21	effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2024 could work irreparable harm
22	upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
23	programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
24	being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
25	and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2024.
