

The following graphs are to provide a general (visual) summary of district's allocation of funds. These graphs are based on an analysis of each district's ACSIP budget page data and were computed manually. While we were extremely careful in recording our data, there is a margin of error. Included are six (6) NSLA graphs (grouped by similar program type), and one graph each for ALE, ELL and Professional Development.

Each NSLA graph has a program list and a summary of how funds may be used. For all programs, the object Capital Outlay refers to equipment over \$1000 and Other Objects refers to dues and fees at both the district and building level.


NSLA - District's Use of Funds - Chart I








