1 Section 1 herein. 2 SECTION 6. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 3 4 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 5 DISBURSEMENTS. The Secretary of the Senate/Fiscal Officer shall be 6 disbursing officer for the funds appropriated for Interim Expense 7 Reimbursements for Senators herein. 8 SECTION 7. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 9 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. HOUSE 10 11 DISBURSEMENTS. The Coordinator of House Legislative Services of the House of 12 Representatives shall be disbursing officer for the funds appropriated for Interim Expense Reimbursements for Representatives herein. 13 14 15 SECTION 8. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 16 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. HOUSE INTERIM EXPENSE REIMBURSEMENTS. The appropriations authorized in Section 217 18 shall be used for making reimbursements for interim expenses incurred by 19 members of the House of Representatives. 20 21 SECTION 9. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 22 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. SENATE 2.3 INTERIM EXPENSE DISBURSEMENTS. The appropriations authorized in Section 3 24 shall be used for making reimbursements for interim expenses incurred by 25 members of the Senate. 26 SECTION 10. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 27 28 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. LEGISLATIVE INSTITUTE. Members of the preceding General Assembly and the 29 30 newly elected members of the House of Representatives and Senate shall be 31 eligible to attend the biennial Institute of Legislative Procedure and shall 32 be entitled, upon filing claim therefor, to per diem in the amount fixed by 33 law for members of the General Assembly to receive for attendance at 34 Legislative sessions, for each day in attending the biennial Institute of Legislative Procedure plus mileage for traveling from their place of 35 36 residence to the biennial Institute of Legislative Procedure and return.

LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 18 19 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations 20 21 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by 22 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral 2.3 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or 24 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 25 26 SECTION 13. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General 27 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the 2.8 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2003 is essential to the operation of 29 30 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective 31 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2003 could work irreparable harm upon the 32 33 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. 34 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and 35

safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2003.
