25 SECTION 10. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 26 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 27 LEGISLATIVE INSTITUTE. Members of the preceding General Assembly and the 28 newly elected members of the House of Representatives and Senate shall be 29 eligible to attend the biennial Institute of Legislative Procedure and shall 30 be entitled, upon filing claim therefor, to per diem in the amount fixed by 31 law for members of the General Assembly to receive for attendance at 32 Legislative sessions, for each day in attending the biennial Institute of 33 Legislative Procedure plus mileage for traveling from their place of 34 residence to the biennial Institute of Legislative Procedure and return. 35 SECTION 11. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly 36

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that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. SECTION 12. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2005 is essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2005 could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2005.
