16 AN ACT TO ENSURE THE QUALITY, SECURITY,
17 VALIDATION, AND TIMELINESS OF PUBLIC
18 SCHOOL DATA IN THE ARKANSAS PUBLIC
19 SCHOOL COMPUTER NETWORK.

22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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24 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-11-128, concerning the Arkansas Public
25 School Computer Network, is amended to add an additional section to read as
26 follows:

27 (a)(1) As used in this section, "Arkansas Public School Computer
28 Network" or "APSCN" means the Department of Education's computer network
29 system for public school district reporting of financial management data and
30 student management data to the Department of Education.

31 (2) ~~Beginning with the 2003-2004 fiscal year, all~~ All school
32 districts and educational cooperatives shall, as a minimum, use the following
33 financial management systems applications of the Arkansas Public School
34 Computer Network:

35 ~~(1)(A)~~ (A) Fund accounting, including all activity funds;



- 1 ~~(2)~~(B) Budget preparation;
2 ~~(3)~~(C) Human resources; and
3 ~~(4)~~(D) Fixed assets.

4 (b) After approval by the ~~Department of Education~~ department, a school
5 district may use a different software system at the district level if:

6 (1) The department determines that the district's software meets
7 the minimum reporting requirements provided by the network; and

8 (2) The district supplies all district transaction information
9 to the network in a compatible format and in sufficient detail as required by
10 the department.

11 (c) The department shall implement the use of policies, procedures,
12 and personnel to provide for data quality and security with the Arkansas
13 Public School Computer Network, including without limitation the following:

14 (1) Periodically conducting a thorough security review and
15 security risk assessment for all information, including without limitation
16 personally identifiable employee and student information, that originates in
17 the school districts and terminates on Department of Information Systems and
18 Arkansas Public School Computer Network servers;

19 (2) The department shall:

20 (A) Create security plans, policies, procedures;

21 (B) Monitor the mechanism for the network's end-to-end,
22 enterprise-wide financial and student information systems;

23 (C) Create and maintain a process for documenting and
24 monitoring the quality of data from its source of entry into the network to
25 any educational data repository in the department; and

26 (D) Establish standards and monitor compliance with
27 standards for all software and data testing in the network.

28 (3)(A) Developing a certification program to certify:

29 (i) At least one (1) person in each school district
30 as a certified APSCN financials user and trainer; and

31 (ii) At least one (1) person in each school district
32 as a certified APSCN student management user and trainer.

33 (B) The certification process shall require an applicant
34 for certification to successfully complete the following components,
35 including without limitation:

36 (i) Courses in the application area;

1 (ii) Training in using the network's reporting
2 tools; and

3 (iii) An examination that tests the applicant's
4 knowledge and skills in the application area and the network's reporting
5 tools.

6 (C) In a school district of five hundred (500) or fewer
7 students, one (1) person may be certified in both financials and student
8 management; and

9 (4) Developing a data quality metrics program designed to:

10 (A) Significantly reduce the number of data errors within
11 the network's applications and data warehouse and provide reports on code
12 changes and time availability of information, including without limitation:

13 (i) The number of code changes made in mid-year;

14 (ii) The percent of prime time availability of all
15 applications that feed data into the network and data warehouse;

16 (iii) The percent of time availability of each
17 school district server and local area network for use with the network's
18 availability;

19 (iv) Corrective actions taken on the network's
20 applications and data warehouse;

21 (v) Preventive actions taken to avoid downtime and
22 data errors;

23 (vi) Cycle data tardiness; and

24 (vii) Number of data corrections made during each
25 cycle submission.
