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1	AN ACT TO PERMIT COUNTY HOSPITALS TO PAY MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS	
2	OR SERVICE ON THE BOARD, MEETING ATTENDANCE, AND TRAINING.	
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5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:	
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7	SECTION 1. The General Assembly finds that:	
8	(1)(A) The increasing complexity of medical care and related	
9	financial, legal, and other issues facing county hospital boards creates the	
10	necessity for members of these boards to spend a substantial amount of time	
11	to become properly informed regarding issues before the board;	
12	(B) It is essential that county hospitals be able to	
13	attract and retain county hospital board members with the experience and	
14	education requisite to a good and proper understanding of the complex	
15	medical, financial, legal, and other issues pertinent to the proper	
16	establishment and maintenance of county hospital operations; and	
17	(C) The boards of existing county hospital operations	
18	throughout the state routinely must collect, budget, and disburse, many	
19	millions of dollars in the course of county hospital operations; and	
20	(2) Therefore:	
21	(A) Serving as a member of a county hospital board is no	
22	longer an honorary position, but requires a great deal of diligence, time,	
23	effort, and study to properly discharge the duties of the office for the	
24	benefit of the county, its citizens, and the county hospital's patients;	
25	(B) The quorum court of each county that has or	
26	establishes a county hospital should be authorized to pay compensation for	
27	the members of the county hospital board; and	
28	(C) Any compensation should be payable solely from	
29	revenues derived from county hospital operations.	
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31	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § Title 14, Chapter 263, Subchapter 1 is	
32	ended to add an additional section to read as follows:	
33	14-263-107. Payment to members of county hospital boards of directors	
34	for board service, meeting attendance, and training.	
35	(a) A county hospital may pay the members of the board of directors of	
36	the county hospital for service on the board, for attendance at board	

1	meetings, and for training relevant to service on the board.
2	(b) Payments under this section shall be made only from revenues
3	derived from county hospital operations.
4	(c) The quorum court shall determine the types and amounts of
5	compensation to be paid to board members under this section."
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
