19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 16-89-111 is amended to read as follows:
22 16-89-111. Evidence generally.

23 (a) The state must then offer the evidence in support of the
24 indictment.

25 (b) The defendant or his or her counsel must then offer the
26 defendant's evidence in support of his or her defense.

27 (c) The parties may then respectively offer rebutting evidence only,
28 unless the court for good reason, in furtherance of justice, permits them to
29 offer evidence upon their original cases.

30 (d) A confession of a defendant, unless made in open court, will not
31 warrant a conviction unless ~~accompanied with other proof that the offense was~~
32 ~~committed~~ there is substantial independent evidence which would tend to
33 establish the trustworthiness of the confession.

34 (e)(1)(A) A conviction or an adjudication of delinquency cannot be had
35 in any case of felony upon the testimony of an accomplice, including in the
36 juvenile division of circuit court, unless corroborated by other evidence



1 tending to connect the defendant or the juvenile with the commission of the
2 offense.

3 (B) The corroboration is not sufficient if it merely shows
4 that the offense was committed and the circumstances thereof.

5 (2) However, a conviction may be had in misdemeanor cases upon
6 the testimony of an accomplice.
