21	WHEREAS, horses hold a revered place in American society and serve
22	humans in sport, recreation, and as partners in work and law enforcement;
23	
24	WHEREAS, horse slaughter is inherently cruel and is not an acceptable
25	form of disposing of horses;
26	
27	WHEREAS, statistics demonstrate that horse slaughter does not alleviate
28	neglect or cruelty;
29	
30	WHEREAS, horse slaughter has been decreasing for decades without
31	causing abandonment of horses;
32	
33	WHEREAS, record gas prices, a severe drought, high prices for hay and
34	feed, and a weak economy are affecting the ability of owners to provide care
35	for their animals and are resulting in the neglect of all species of farm
36	animals, including horses;

2	WHEREAS, statistics from the United States Department of Agriculture
3	show that more than ninety-two percent of all horses that go to slaughter are
4	in good health;
5	
6	WHEREAS, horse owners have many options if they can no longer keep
7	their horses, such as resale to new owners, placement at equine rescues
8	or sanctuaries, or humane euthanasia,
9	
10	NOW THEREFORE,
11	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE EIGHTY-SEVENTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE
12	STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:
13	
14	That the Arkansas General Assembly urges Arkansans to act responsibly
15	to ensure the humane care and treatment of their companion animals during
16	this time of economic crisis.
