- 29 of Arkansas State Police Fund in the same amount and for the same purposes as
- 30 the appropriation transfer requested under the provisions of this section.
- 31 The provisions of this section shall be subject to prior review and approval
- 32 of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee.
- 33 Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of
- 34 appropriation and general revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year
- 35 is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by
- 36 delineating such maximums in the appropriation act(s) for a state agency and

- 1 the general revenue allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by
- 2 amendment to the Revenue Stabilization law. Further, the General Assembly
- 3 has determined that the Department of Arkansas State Police may operate more
- 4 efficiently if some flexibility is provided to the Department of Arkansas
- 5 State Police authorizing broad powers under this Section. Therefore, it is
- 6 both necessary and appropriate that the General Assembly maintain oversight
- 7 by requiring prior approval of the Legislative Council or Joint Budget
- 8 Committee as provided by this section. The requirement of approval by the

- 11 Budget Committee is ruled unconstitutional by a court of competent
- 12 jurisdiction, this entire section is void.

- 28 The Department of Arkansas State Police is hereby authorized to make overtime
- 29 payments from such funds and appropriations provided for overtime payments to
- 30 those officers or other employees that are currently assigned or may be
- 31 assigned by the Director of the Department of Arkansas State Police to
- 32 Special Law Enforcement Task Forces and other special programs reimbursable
- 33 to Arkansas State Police by federal or local authorities as approved by the

SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 16 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 17 EMPLOYEE HEALTH INSURANCE PROGRAM REPORTING. The Department of Arkansas 18 State Police shall report monthly to the Governor, the Chief Fiscal Officer 19 of the State and to the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget 20 Committee regarding the activity and condition for the uniformed employee 21 health insurance plan. The report shall include, but not limited to, the 22 beginning reserve fund balance, contributions made during the month, claims 23 paid, and the ending fund balance of the month. In the event it is determined 24 that the cost to adequately maintain the uniform employee health insurance 25 plan is not feasible within the existing resources available to the 26 department, the 88th General Assembly shall study the feasibility and 27 desirability of discontinuing the self-insurance program and instead provide 28 medical and hospital insurance to uniform employees through the public 29 employees insurance program. 30 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 31 20102012 through June 30, 20112013. 32 33 SECTION 20. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 34 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 35 EXTRAORDINARY EXPENSES. The Department of Arkansas State Police is hereby

authorized to purchase from Maintenance & Operations Classifications in the

- Operations Appropriation provided by in this Act, up to an amount not to exceed two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500) each fiscal year, for emergency purchases for food, drinks and other essential items during emergency operations only when authorized by the Agency Director. During an emergency, an ASP employee may be designated and authorized, by the Director,
- to incur expenses for all deployed personnel.
  The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1,
  2010/2012 through June 30, 2011/2013.

SECTION 21. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS

CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FLAGS.

The Department of Arkansas State Police is hereby authorized to award one (1)

United States flag to the family of any Arkansas State Police Commissioned

Officer killed in the line of duty. This provision will be effective for
Arkansas State Police Commissioned Officers killed in the line of duty after
July 1, 2011.

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1,  $\frac{2011}{2012}$  to June 30,  $\frac{2012}{2013}$ .

SECTION 22. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative

1	Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
2	
3	SECTION 24. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
4	General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits
5	the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
6	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2012 is essential to the operation of
7	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
8	the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
9	effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2012 could work irreparable harm
10	upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
11	programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
12	being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
13	and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2012.
