15 TO CREATE AN EXCEPTION TO THE REQUIREMENT
16 THAT A CITY OR TOWN HAVE A REFERENDUM
17 ELECTION TO AUTHORIZE THE SALE OF
18 ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES FOR ON-PREMISES
19 CONSUMPTION; TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY.

23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
24

25 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 3-9-203, concerning an exception to the
26 requirement that a city or town have a referendum election for on-premises
27 consumption of alcohol, is amended to add an additional subsection to read as
28 follows:

29 (d) A city or town may authorize by ordinance the sale of alcoholic
30 beverages for on-premises consumption under § 3-9-201 et seq. if:

31 (1) The city or town is located in a county that authorized the
32 manufacture and sale of intoxicating liquor after November 1, 2012; and

33 (2) The county in which the city or town is located has one
34 hundred (100) active Alcoholic Beverage Control Division permits at the time
35 the city or town chooses to authorize on-premises consumption.
