6	SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 6-17-1202(3), concerning the definition of
7	"month or major portion thereof" under the Teachers' Minimum Sick Leave Law,

23	SECTION 5. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
24	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that the Public School Insurance
25	Trust Fund is inadequate to provide affordable health insurance for public
26	school employees; changes to the funding system for public school employee
27	health insurance is necessary to ensure a stable and affordable program of
28	health insurance plan options; and that this act is necessary to provide
