

17 EXPRESSING THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY'S SUPPORT
18 FOR THE BALLOT TITLES AND POPULAR NAMES
19 SELECTED BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE FOR
20 THE PROPOSED CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENTS
21 REFERRED TO THE PEOPLE AT THE 2013
22 REGULAR SESSION.

25 WHEREAS, at a January 23, 2014 meeting of the House Committee on State
26 Agencies and Governmental Affairs and Senate Committee on State Agencies and
27 Governmental Affairs, the Secretary of State stated his plan of action for
28 the ballot titles and popular names of the three (3) proposed constitutional
29 amendments referred to the people of Arkansas by the General Assembly at its
30 2013 regular session; and

32 WHEREAS, the Secretary of State plans to use the title of the
33 respective joint resolution as the ballot title and will use a popular name
34 provided by the Attorney General for that purpose; and

36 WHEREAS, the intentions of the Secretary of State are consistent with



1 the intent of the General Assembly when voting to refer the respective joint
2 resolutions to the people of Arkansas and reflect the law in place when the
3 joint resolutions were adopted by the General Assembly,

5 NOW THEREFORE,

6 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE EIGHTY-NINTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE
7 STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:

9 THAT the General Assembly expresses its agreement with the decision of
10 the Secretary of State to use the title of each respective joint resolution
11 as the ballot title and a popular name provided by the Attorney General.

13 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the General Assembly declares that the use
14 of the title of the joint resolution as the ballot title and a popular name
15 provided by the Attorney General is consistent with the intent of the General
16 Assembly when voting to refer the proposed amendments to the people of
17 Arkansas for their consideration.
