8 **HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION**

9 TO PROVIDE FOR A RECESS OF THE NINETIETH GENERAL  
10 ASSEMBLY AT THE CLOSE OF BUSINESS ON MAY 20, 2016; TO  
11 PROVIDE FOR AN EXTENSION OF THE FISCAL SESSION OF THE  
12 NINETIETH GENERAL ASSEMBLY UNTIL 12:00 NOON, MAY 27,  
13 2016; TO AUTHORIZE THE PRESIDENT PRO TEMPORE OF THE  
14 SENATE AND THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE OF  
15 REPRESENTATIVES, BY JOINT PROCLAMATION, TO RECONVENE  
16 THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY AT ANY TIME BEFORE 12:00 NOON,  
17 MAY 27, 2016, FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONSIDERING VETOES,  
18 CORRECTING ERRORS OR OVERSIGHTS, OR TO ADJOURN THE  
19 NINETIETH GENERAL ASSEMBLY AT ANY TIME BEFORE THAT  
20 DATE IF THEY DETERMINE THAT THERE IS NO NEED TO  
21 RECONVENE; TO PROVIDE THAT IF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY IS  
22 NOT RECONVENED OR ADJOURNED BEFORE 12:00 NOON, MAY  
23 27, 2016, THE FISCAL SESSION OF THE NINETIETH GENERAL  
24 ASSEMBLY IS ADJOURNED SINE DIE ON THAT DATE; AND TO  
25 AUTHORIZE ADDITIONAL RECESSES OF EITHER OR BOTH  
26 CHAMBERS FOR PERIODS OF FOUR (4) CONSECUTIVE DAYS OR  
27 LONGER.

31 TO PROVIDE FOR AN EXTENSION AND SINE DIE  
32 ADJOURNMENT OF THE FISCAL SESSION OF THE  
33 NINETIETH GENERAL ASSEMBLY AND TO PROVIDE  
34 FOR RECESSES OF THE HOUSE OF  
35 REPRESENTATIVES AND THE SENATE.

2 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE NINETIETH GENERAL  
3 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:  
4

5 (a) That the Fiscal Session of the Ninetieth General Assembly of the  
6 State of Arkansas is extended until 12:00 noon, May 27, 2016;

7 (b) That the Fiscal Session of the Ninetieth General Assembly of the  
8 State of Arkansas shall enter into recess at the close of business in each  
9 chamber on May 20, 2016, or at an earlier time as may be agreed upon by the  
10 House of Representatives and the Senate;

11 (c) That under Arkansas Constitution, Article 6, § 15, before  
12 adjournment of the General Assembly, the Governor is afforded five (5) days  
13 after receipt of a bill to sign a bill or veto a bill; therefore, from May  
14 20, 2016, to May 27, 2016, the House of Representatives and the Senate shall  
15 be open so that the office of the Chief Clerk of the House of Representatives  
16 and the office of the Secretary of the Senate may receive communications,  
17 vetoes of bills by the Governor, and notification of errors and oversights;

18 (d) That the Speaker of the House of Representatives and the President  
19 Pro Tempore of the Senate may, by joint proclamation:

20 (1) Reconvene the General Assembly at any time before 12:00  
21 noon, May 27, 2016, for the purpose of:

22 (A) Considering vetoes; or

23 (B) Correcting errors and oversights; or

24 (2) Adjourn the Fiscal Session of the Ninetieth General Assembly  
25 at any time before 12:00 noon, May 27, 2016, if they determine it is not  
26 necessary to reconvene;

27 (e) That if the General Assembly is not reconvened or adjourned before  
28 12:00 noon, May 27, 2016, the Fiscal Session of the Ninetieth General  
29 Assembly is adjourned sine die on that date; and

30 (f) That during the Fiscal Session, in addition to the recess provided  
31 for in subdivision (b) of this section, the:

32 (1) House of Representatives may recess for periods of four (4)  
33 consecutive days or longer, by declaration of the Speaker of the House of  
34 Representatives; and

35 (2) Senate may recess for periods of four (4) consecutive days  
36 or longer, by declaration of the President Pro Tempore of the Senate.
