**Amendment No. 1 to Senate Bill No. 519**

Amend Senate Bill No. 519 as originally introduced:

Page 1, delete lines 32 and 33, and substitute the following:

"(a)(1) The Commissioner of Education shall ~~develop the materials or units~~ update the materials and resources for the teaching of historical contributions made by African-Americans"

AND

Page 2, delete lines 5 through 7, and substitute the following:

"(3)(A) The requirement under this subsection shall be taught in conjunction with corresponding state and federal holidays.

(B) Nothing in subdivision (3)(A) of this section shall be construed to limit the teaching of this history only to the corresponding state and federal holidays."
